McKenzie, 2005-12-12 In this study assessing black civic participation after the civil rights movement Fredrick C Harris Valeria Sinclair Chapman and Brian D McKenzie demonstrate that the changes in black activism since the civil rights movement is characterized by a tug of war between black political power on one side and economic conditions in black communities on the other As blacks gain greater access and influence within the political system black participation in political activities increases while downward turns in the economic conditions of black communities produce less civic involvement in black communities Examining changes in black activism from the early 1970s to the 1990s this tug of war demonstrates that the quest for black political empowerment and the realities of economic and social life act as countervailing forces in which negative economic and social conditions in black communities weaken the capacity of blacks to organize so that their political voices can be heard **Black Americans in Congress, 1870-2007** ,2008 From the publisher Provides a comprehensive history of the more than 120 African Americans who have served in the United States
