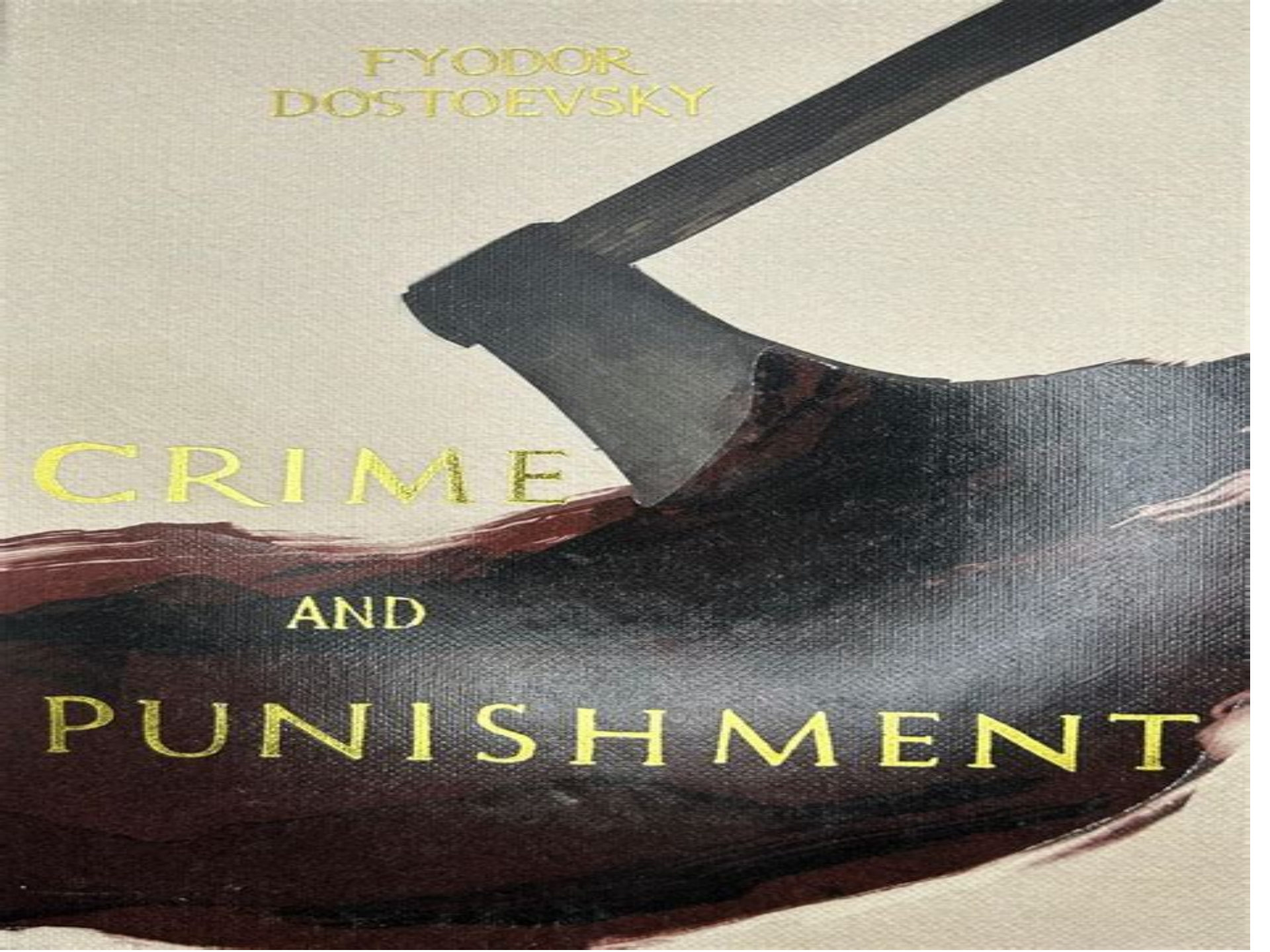

goes like the tide Graeme Newman emphasizes that punishment is a cultural process and also a mechanism of particular institutions of which criminal law is but one Because academic discussions of punishment have been confined to legalistic preoccupations much of the policy and justification of punishment have been based on discussions of extreme cases The use of punishment in the sphere of crime is an extreme unto itself since crime is a minor aspect of daily life The uses of punishment and the moral justifications for punishment within the family and school have rarely been considered certainly not to the exhaustive extent that criminal law has been in this outstanding work **The National Schoolmaster** ,1881
