Anne Finch and Her Poetry Barbara McGovern, 1992 *Anne Finch and Her Poetry* is the first major critical examination of the life and works of the foremost English woman poet of the eighteenth century This biography places Anne Finch 1661 1720 in her social and literary milieu and includes discussion of such topics as love and marriage female friendships melancholy and nature as they relate both to Finch s life and to her poetry Barbara McGovern gives considerable attention to the methods by which Finch developed her artistry and molded a largely masculine literary tradition to her own designs through a variety of rhetorical and stylistic devices She examines the entire body of Finch s work including two verse plays and a number of previously unpublished poems and letters and corrects numerous misconceptions about the poet and her work Though recognized in her lifetime as a talented poet for nearly two hundred years Finch has been overlooked or when anthologized misrepresented McGovern focuses on the historical place and displacement of Finch in Restoration and early eighteenth century England in terms of her involvement with Britain s most critical religious and political controversies An Anglican and Royalist who along with her husband was attached to the Stuart court at the time of the Glorious Revolution Finch was an outsider because of her politics and religion as well as her gender Despite her marginal status in society Anne Finch was able to develop her poetic identity in part by defining her relationships with other early women writers including Katherine Philips and Aphra Behn Her female friendships as well as aristocratic family ties and titled position gave her access to a number of the most famous literary figures of her age including Alexander Pope and Jonathan Swift A thoroughly researched well written and compelling work *Anne Finch and Her Poetry* will no doubt become the standard biography of the finest woman poet in England before the nineteenth century

The Poetry of Anne Finch Charles H. Hinnant, 1994 At the same time her stance as a feminist led her not only to articulate issues in terms of gender but also to define her poetry in opposition to the dominant literary form of the age satire

The Anne Finch Wellesley Manuscript Poems Anne Kingsmill Finch Countess of Winchelsea, 1998 The publication of the Wellesley manuscript marks the first complete edition of fifty three poems by the most talented and significant woman poet of the Restoration and eighteenth century Anne Finch 1661 1720 wrote most of these poems in the last decade of her life and they are essential to a complete evaluation of her work This authoritative edition edited by Barbara McGovern and Charles H Hinnant is useful for scholars as well as general readers of eighteenth century poetry and women s literature It contains textual notes commentary and an introduction that examines many of the issues relevant to Finch s poetry including political climate literary milieu personal circumstances and gender awareness The

editors also discuss Finch's devotional verse and her poetry in praise of female friendship offering new insight into her attitudes toward these themes. These poems were not published during Finch's lifetime nor in a posthumous collection and subsequently fell into obscurity until the manuscript resurfaced in the twentieth century. McGovern and Hinnant suggest that this had to do with the dangerous political environment in England particularly following the Jacobite rebellion of 1715. Not only do these poems help to define Finch's stature as a poet; they also provide a valuable perspective on the politics of the early woman writer.

British Women Poets of the Long Eighteenth Century Paula R. Backscheider, Catherine E. Ingrassia, 2022-10-01. This anthology gathers 368 poems by 80 British women poets of the long eighteenth century. Few of these poems have been reprinted since originally published and all are crucial to understanding fully the literary history of women writers. Paula R. Backscheider and Catherine E. Ingrassia demonstrate the enormous diversity of poetry produced during this time by organizing the poems in three broad and deliberately overlapping categories by genre, establishing that women wrote in all of the forms that men did with equal mastery and creativity by theme, offering a revisionary look at the range of topics these writers addressed including war, ecology, friendship, religion, and the stages of life, and by the poems' more specific focus on the women's experiences as writers. Backscheider and Ingrassia have selected poems that represent the best work of skilled poets, creating a wonderful mix of canonical and little-known pieces. They include the complete texts of longer poems that are abridged or omitted in other collections. Their substantial part introductions, textual notes, bibliographical information, and biographical sketches situate the poets and their writings within the cultural and political milieu in which they appeared. To generate further scholarship on this subject, this essential anthology puts primary texts in front of students, scholars, and general readers. It fills the persistent need to document women's poetic expression during the long eighteenth century and to rewrite the literary history of the period, a history from which women have largely been excluded.

Eighteenth-Century Women Poets and Their Poetry Paula R. Backscheider, 2005-12-31. Co-Winner James Russell Lowell Prize, Modern Language Association. This major study offers a broad view of the writing and careers of eighteenth-century women poets, casting new light on the ways in which poetry was read and enjoyed, on changing poetic tastes in British culture, and on the development of many major poetic genres and traditions. Rather than presenting a chronological survey, Paula R. Backscheider explores the forms in which women wrote and the uses to which they put those forms. Considering more than forty women in relation to canonical male writers of the same era, she concludes that women wrote in all of the genres that men did but often adapted, revised, and even created new poetic kinds from traditional forms. Backscheider demonstrates that knowledge of these women's poetry is necessary for an accurate and nuanced literary history. Within chapters on important canonical and popular verse forms, she gives particular attention to such topics as

John Armstrong's *The Art of Preserving Health* Adam Budd, 2016-05-06 John Armstrong's 2000 line poem *The Art of Preserving Health* was among the most popular works of eighteenth century literature and medicine It was among the first to popularize Scottish medical ideas concerning emotional and anatomical sensibility to British readers doing so through the then fashionable georgic style Within three years of its publication in 1744 it was in its third edition and by 1795 it commanded fourteen editions printed in London Edinburgh Dublin and Benjamin Franklin's shop in Philadelphia Maintaining its place amongst more famous works of the Enlightenment this poem was read well into the nineteenth century remaining in print in English French and Italian It remained a tribute to sustained interest in eighteenth century sensibility long after its medical advice had become obsolete and the nervous complaints it depicted became unfashionable Adam Budd's critical edition includes a comprehensive biographical and textual introduction and explanatory notes highlighting the contemporary significance of Armstrong's classical medical and social references Included in his introduction are discussions of Armstrong's innovative medical training in charity hospitals and his close associations with the poet James Thomson and the bookseller Andrew Millar evidence for the poem's wide appeal and a compelling argument for the poem's anticipation of sensibility as a dominant literary mode Budd also offers background on the new physiology taught at Edinburgh as well as an explanation for why a Scottish trained physician newly arrived in London was forced to write poetry to supplement his medical income This edition also includes annotated excerpts from the key literary and medical works of the period including poetry medical prose and georgic theory Readers will come away convinced of the poem's significance as a uniquely engaging perspective on the place of poetry medicine the body and the book trade in the literary history of eighteenth century sensibility
