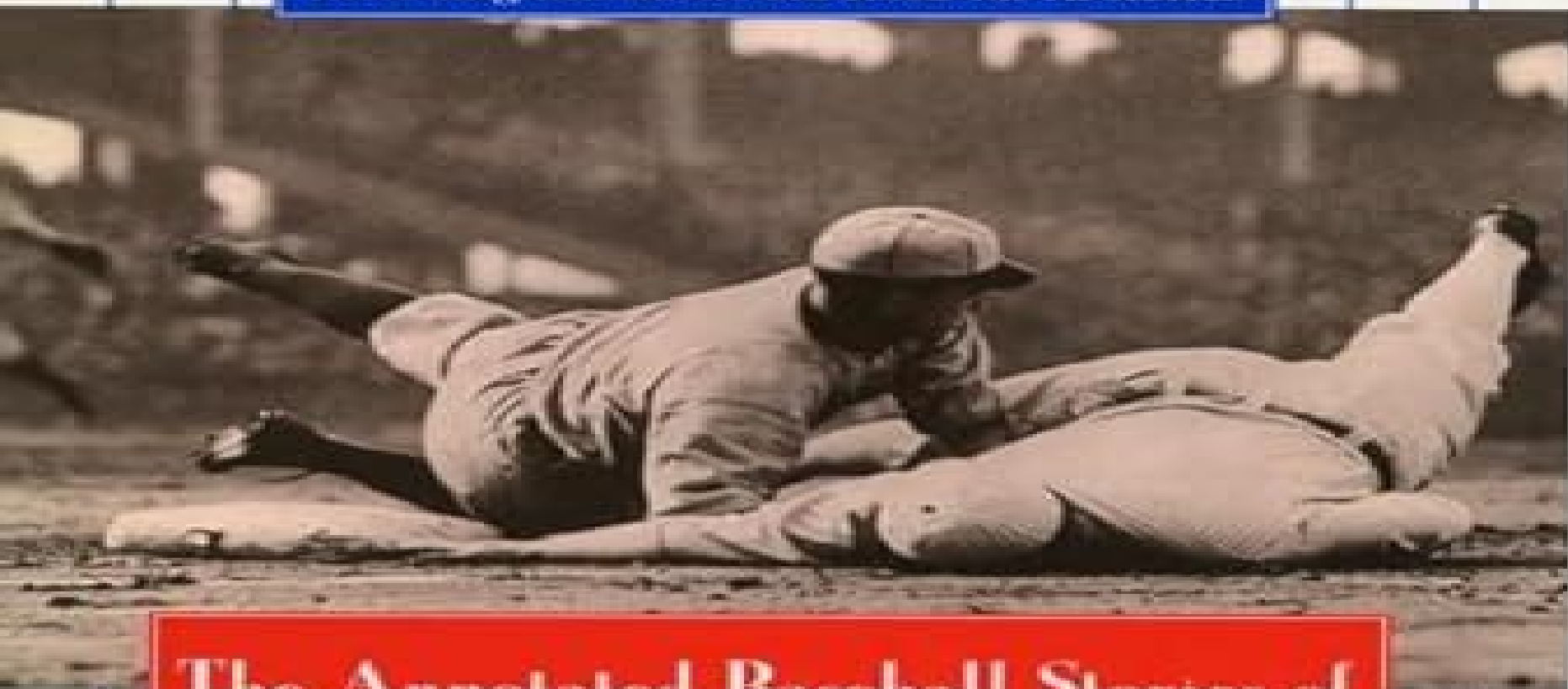

Kates, Warren Tormey, 2012-11-16 This collection of fresh essays examines the intersection of baseball and social class pointing to the conclusion that America's game infused from its origins with a democratic mythos and founded on high minded principles of meritocracy is nonetheless fraught with problematic class contradictions Each essayist has explored how class standing has influenced some aspect of the game as experienced by those who play it those who watch it those who write about it and those who market it The topic of class is an amorphous one and in tying it to baseball the contributors have considered matters of race education locality integration assimilation and cultural standing These elements are crucial to understanding how baseball creates preserves reinforces and occasionally assails class divisions among those who watch play and own the game **You Know Me Al** Ring Lardner, 2004 Ring Lardner America's great humorist and shortstory writer began his career as a sports writer Because of his interest in baseball he began putting stories in his newspaper column that were purportedly written by unlettered athletes Lardner who had an excellent ear for dialogue actually wrote these stories in the voice of the fictional rookie ballplayer Jack Keefe a White Sox pitcher who writes letters to his friend Al Blanchard back home in Bedford Indiana Several streams of American comic tradition merge in You Know Me Al the comic letter the wisecrack the braggart character the use of sporting vocabulary and fractured English as a means to apologetics This collection of short stories revealed Lardner's talent for the sports idiom he made famous Usually cynical and pessimistic his stories are peopled by ordinary characters Lardner often used his own experiences as the model or inspiration for the fiction he wrote **501 Baseball Books Fans Must Read Before They Die** Ron Kaplan, 2018-08-01 Propounding his small ball theory of sports literature George Plimpton proposed that the smaller the ball the more formidable the literature Of course he had the relatively small baseball in mind because its literature is formidable vast and varied instructive often wildly entertaining and occasionally brilliant From this bewildering array of baseball books Ron Kaplan has chosen 501 of the best making it easier for fans to find just the books to suit them or to know what they're missing From biography history fiction and instruction to books about ballparks business and rules anyone who loves to read about baseball will find in this book a companionable guide far more fun than a reference work has any right to be **James T. Farrell and Baseball** Charles DeMotte, 2019-12-01 James T Farrell and Baseball is a social history of baseball on Chicago's South Side drawing on the writings of novelist James T Farrell along with historical sources Charles DeMotte shows how baseball in the early decades of the twentieth century developed on all levels and in all areas of Chicago America's second largest city at the time and how that growth intertwined with Farrell's development as a

fan and a writer who used baseball as one of the major themes of his work DeMotte goes beyond Farrell's literary focus to tell a larger story about baseball on Chicago's South Side during this time when Charles Comiskey's White Sox won two World Series and were part of a rich baseball culture that was widely played at the amateur semipro and black ball levels DeMotte highlights the 1919-20 Black Sox fix and scandal which traumatized not only Farrell and Chicago but also baseball and the broader culture By tying Farrell's fictional and nonfictional works to Chicago's vibrant baseball history this book fills an important gap in the history of baseball during the Deadball Era

Scandal on the South Side Jacob Pomrenke, 2015-06

The Black Sox Scandal is a cold case not a closed case When Eliot Asinof wrote his classic history about the fixing of the 1919 World Series *Eight Men Out* he told a dramatic story of undereducated and underpaid Chicago White Sox ballplayers disgruntled by their low pay and poor treatment by team management who fell prey to the wiles of double crossing big city gamblers offering them bribes to lose the World Series to the Cincinnati Reds Shoeless Joe Jackson Buck Weaver Eddie Cicotte and the other Black Sox players were all banned from organized baseball for life But the real story is a lot more complex We now have access to crucial information that changes what we thought we knew about baseball's darkest hour including rare film footage from that fateful fall classic legal documents from the criminal and civil court proceedings and accurate salary information for major league players and teams All of these new pieces to the Black Sox puzzle provide definitive answers to some old mysteries and raise other questions in their place However the Black Sox Scandal isn't the only story worth telling about the 1919 Chicago White Sox The team roster included three future Hall of Famers a 20 year old spitballer who would go on to win 300 games in the minor leagues and even a batboy who later became a celebrity with the Murderers Row New York Yankees in the 1920s All of their stories are included in *Scandal on the South Side* which has full life biographies on each of the 31 players who made an appearance for the White Sox in 1919 plus a comprehensive recap of Chicago's pennant winning season the tainted World Series and the sordid aftermath This book isn't a rewriting of *Eight Men Out* but it is the complete story of everyone associated with the 1919 Chicago White Sox
