Narrative Analogy in the Hebrew Bible Joshua Berman,2004-07-01 This volume sheds fresh light upon the phenomenon of narrative doubling in the Hebrew Bible Through an innovative interdisciplinary model the author defines the notion of narrative analogy in relation to other literatures where it has been studied such as English Renaissance drama and makes extensive critical use of contemporary literary theory particularly that of the Russian formalist Vladimir Propp His exploitation of narrative doubling with a focus upon the metaphorical reorients our reading by uncovering a major dynamic in biblical literature The author examines several battle reports and demonstrates how each could be interpreted as an oblique commentary and metaphor for the non battle account that immediately precedes it Battle scenes are revealed to stand in metaphoric analogy with among others accounts of a trial a rape a drinking feast and a court deliberation Joshua Berman offers new insights to the ever growing concern with the relationship between historiography and literary strategies and succeeds in articulating a new aspect of biblical ideology concerning human and divine relationship *Studies in the Book of Job* Walter E. Rumors of Wisdom Scott C. Jones,2009 Efforts at interpreting Joban poetry have often been divided between philological and literary critics This study brings these two critical modes together to offer an account of how Job 28 achieves meaning The heart of the study consists of two major sections The first is a reading of the poem with special attention to the conceptual background of its metaphors Rather than a poetic account of mining technology Job 28 is properly understood against the heroic deeds of ancient Mesopotamian kings described in Sumerian and Akkadian royal narratives especially the Gilgamesh epic The second major section is a thorough philological and textual commentary in which comparative philological and text critical methods are complemented by an aesthetic rationale for restoring the text of the poem as a work

of art The study reveals a multileveled and image driven masterpiece whose complexity impacts how one reads Job 28 as poetry and theology

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web an innovative and prolific master in three media 3 he is generally considered one of the greatest visual artists in the history of art 4 it is estimated rembrandt produced a total of about three hundred paintings three hundred etchings and two thousand drawings

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web october 2003 a prolific painter draftsman and etcher rembrandt van rijen is usually regarded as the greatest artist of holland's golden age he worked first in his native leiden and from 1632 onward in amsterdam where he had studied briefly ca 1624 with the influential history painter pieter lastman

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web from approximately 1620 to 1624 25 rembrandt trained as an artist as was quite common in his time he had two masters in succession rembrandt's first master was the leiden painter jacob van swanenburgh 1571 1638 with whom according to orlers he remained for about three years van swanenburgh must have taught him the basic skills

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web jun 7 2021 rembrandt harmenszoon van rijn commonly known as rembrandt was a seventeenth century dutch artist renowned for his portraiture work rembrandt s career spanned various subjects and styles but he is best known for his honest and empathetic portraits especially his self portraits and depictions of biblical scenes

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web an innovative and prolific master in three media he is generally considered one of the greatest visual artists in the history of art and the most important in dutch art history unlike most dutch masters of the 17th century rembrandt s works depict a wide range of style and subject matter from portraits and self portraits to landscapes

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web we know that at least two of rembrandt s pupils went into independent art careers govaert flinck and ferdinand bol their art reflects to some degree rembrandt s influence which is expected as they learned to paint in his style however with time their style developed into their own list of rembrandt s pupils and collaborators
