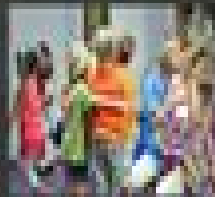
Key principles for Vygotsky's theory of social learning

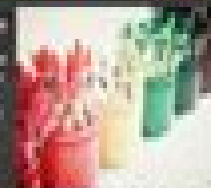
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Principles of Montessori Method

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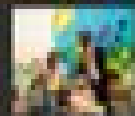
