#### APPROPRIATE AND SUSTAINABLE WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT IN DEVELOPING COUNTRIES BY THE USE OF CONSTRUCTED WETLANDS

#### ABSTRACT

Constructed wetland systems for wastewater management may have great potential in developing countries as robust and decentralized solution. A case study from Koh Phi Phi island in Thailand where a constructed wetland systems was established after the destructions by the tsunami in 2004 is described. The project includes a wastewater collection system for the main business area of the island, a pumping station, a multistage constructed wetland system, and a system for reuse of treated wastewater. The wastewater is treated to meet the Thai effluent standards for total suspended solids and nitrogen. but because of inadequate pre-treatment and removal of oil and grease prior to the system, the standards for oil and grease and BOD are not met. The experiences from the project illustrate, that despite the appropriateness of the system, and the fact that safeguards were prepared beforehand, the system is only partly a success, mainly because no key-person or key-authority responsibility for managing the system.

#### 1. Introduction

Malfunctioning wastewater management systems in developing countries have become a growing concern during recent decades. The high-tech centralised sewer and treatment systems used in the more developed countries cannot be readily adopted in developing countries because the political, educational, legislative, institutional, and financial systems are often inadequate. Yet the needs are growing, but the resources are scarce, and there is therefore an urgent need for a shift in the approach to wastewater management and planning.

Wastewater management systems in developing countries should be based on the principles of sustainability and appropriateness. Most developing countries have not yet made investments in centralised sewer and treatment systems, and therefore have potentials for experimenting with new and perhaps more suitable short- and long term concepts for wastewater management. The idea that wastewater management systems in developing countries should be based on the principles of appropriateness and sustainability have been advocated in a recent book "Santainabile Wastewater Management in Developing Countries – New paradigms and Case Studies from the Field" published by the authors [1]. Here we summarise the ideas put forward in the book and illustrate the principles by a case story from Thailand. We hope that the lessons learned from the planning, design, implementation and follow up of this wastewater management system can assist in developing a more appropriate and sustainable wastewater management practice in developing countries in the future.

#### 2. Appropriateness and sustainability

The basic characteristic of an appropriate wastewater management system is that, at a given time in history, it fits well with the local setting and culture, and that its relevance and sustainability thereby is ensured. In this context, low-cost, decentralized nature-based wastewater management systems are highly interesting and relevant for developing countries. The concepts of use and reuse, closed-loop systems, recovery, low energy consumptions also points towards the future, as do concepts of integrating urban planning and wastewater management strategies to conserve urban nature resources. Future wastewater management systems should therefore be recovery-based closed-loop systems rather than traditional disposal-based linear systems. Such systems would promote conservation of water and nutrient resources, improve urban environments and contribute to public health, the local economy and the protection of aquatic ecosystems. Systems should be fitted to the local physical, social and institutional context and include a cultural appropriateness reflecting the local perception of e.g. soil, land, recycling and human waste.

#### 3. Fundamentals in developing countries

A number of issues are fundamental to working with wastewater management systems in developing countries. These issues are, however, often overlooked or ignored
