these concern primarily the model concept discussed in Chapter 3 The criteria put forward for optimizing scientific illustrations which are dealt with in Chapter 7 were also originally proposed by Gerd Grahn they were refined and elaborated in the SNF project Some of the material on the copying links presented in this book was first published in 2 an article in Studies in History and Philosophy of Science Part C while some of the material in Chapter 5 on the hand colouring of illustration was 3 published prior to this book in the Annals of Science
