The Jewish Law Annual Bernard S. Jackson, 2023-08-28 Volume 15 of *The Jewish Law Annual* adds to the growing list of articles on Jewish law that have been published in volumes 1-14 of this series providing English speaking readers with scholarly material meeting the highest academic standards. The volume contains six articles diverse in their scope and focus encompassing legal historical textual comparative and conceptual analysis as well as a survey of recent literature and a chronicle of cases of interest. Among the topics covered are: lying in rabbinical court proceedings; unjust enrichment; can a witness serve as judge in the same case; *Caro's Shulham Arukh*; volume Maimonides' *Mishne Torah* in the Yemenite community; the New Jersey *eruv* wards.

Originally written in nine separate volumes *Judaism in Late Antiquity* now appears unabridged in three. The entire work seeks to offer readers both a broad perspective on the shape of Judaism while also opening the way to understanding unique issues. Marriage and Metaphor Gail Susan Labovitz, 2009-01-01 In *Marriage and Metaphor* Gail Labovitz explores gender relations in marriage within rabbinic culture. Labovitz shows how rabbis use the concepts of property and ownership to discuss the roles of a husband and wife thereby modeling marriage after a business transaction, one in which the wife is seen as an acquisition owned by and subject to the husband. This ownership metaphor is clearly present in all strata of rabbinic literature and this book explores how it continues to guide rabbinic thinking, serve as a tool for legal reasoning and produce new linguistic applications. With a close and careful reading of rabbinic texts Labovitz applies metaphor theory and feminist linguistics to demonstrate the ways in which rabbis regularly use information from the realm of property and commercial transactions to structure their understanding of marriage and gender relations. Labovitz examines the qualities deemed masculine and feminine, seeking out the methods used by members of rabbinic culture to promote, contest, legislate and exemplify the ideas and ideals associated with proper normative gender roles. What comes of this is a striking work of feminist scholarship that should be read by those interested in gender studies and Jewish culture and history.
