

2 Corinthians by Geoffrey B. Wilson

When the author's first treatment of a New Testament epistle in this style was published in 1969, a reviewer in *Floodtide* wrote: 'Mr Wilson has done so well something that has not been tried before that he — and others — should be encouraged to treat other New Testament books in this way.' His first 'digest' on *Romans* was subsequently followed by *Hebrews* and *1 Corinthians* and now by *2 Corinthians* and *Galatians* in the same series. Geoffrey Wilson's paperbacks have achieved popularity because they go beyond a simple devotional comment — they aim at bringing the reader to grips with the thoughts of Scripture. Yet this is done without encumbering the page with those niceties of scholarship which too often make a commentary unenjoyable to the ordinary Christian. By drawing upon the exegetical insights of a wide range of commentators the author provides in brief compass the basis necessary for those who wish to possess a serious understanding of the Word of God.
