Nineteen Weeks Norman Moss, 2003 The whirl of events during the spring and summer of 1940 is boggling to contemplate the events in Europe had an immediate impact on the American political scene *Nineteen Weeks* recounts the epic tale of America and Britain confronting the great crush of history and raises important questions about the rise of America to a dominant role in global politics Photo insert *June 1940, Great Britain and the First Attempt to Build a European Union* Andrea Bosco, 2016-06-22 June 2016 represents a significant moment in British history The decision to leave the European Union at the most critical period since its existence could bring unpredictable and far reaching consequences both for the United Kingdom and the Union itself June 1940 was also a turning point in British history On the afternoon of 16 June a few hours before the French Government opted for the capitulation Churchill made on behalf of the British Government an offer of indissoluble union When a sceptical Churchill put forward to the British Cabinet the text of the declaration drafted by Jean Monnet Sir Arthur Salter and Robert Vansittart he was surprised at the amount of support it received The Cabinet adopted the document with some minor amendments and de Gaulle who saw it as a means of keeping France in the war telephoned Reynaud with the proposal for an indissoluble union with joint organs of defence foreign financial and economic policies a common citizenship and a single War Cabinet The proposal however never reached the table of the French Government The spirit of capitulation embodied in Weygand and P tain prevailed and France submitted herself to the German will for the second time in seventy years After the Munich crisis Great Britain had to face the danger of another European war with the inevitable loss of the Empire and it was at this point that the country first began to favour the application of the federalist principle to Anglo French relations In this conversion to federalism a fundamental role was played by the Federal Union the first federalist movement organised on a popular basis The contribution of Federal Union to the development of the federal idea in Great Britain and Europe was to express and organise the beginning of a new political militancy and it represented the first step of a historical process the overcoming of the nation State the modern political formula which institutionalises the political division of mankind This study principally examines the first eighteen months of the Federal Union during which time it was able to raise itself to the attention of the general public and the political class as the heir of the League of Nations Union The research is based on extensive unpublished archival material found across the globe from London Oxford Brighton and Edinburgh to Washington Paris and Geneva *Wealth of an Empire* Robert Switky, 2013-09-30 *Wealth of an Empire* tells the dramatic true story of a top secret mission that changed the course of World War II Great Britain s shipment of virtually its entire treasury across the treacherous waters of the North Atlantic to safety in the United States and Canada Had the Germans captured or sunk the treasure laden ships the war could have been lost more than eighteen months before the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor The British government authorized this immensely risky and long running operation not only because of the obvious danger that Germany s rising militancy posed but also because of

the isolationist sentiment that permeated both American society and Congress America's refusal to sell arms and other goods without payment up front left Britain little choice but to mount this daring operation Only a few banking political and military leaders were responsible for the complicated logistical and security procedures that were designed to safeguard the transfer of both gold and financial securities to North America Although the special shipments were initially of relatively modest value the strategic imperative changed dramatically when Germany threatened to invade Britain in the summer of 1940 Fearing that Britain's wealth might fall into German hands in an audacious yet visionary decision newly installed prime minister Winston Churchill authorized the evacuation of nearly all of Britain's liquid assets Wealth of an Empire uses previously unused and unavailable original documents including those from the British National Archives the Bank of England's archives the Imperial War Museum and the Bank of Canada's archives to shed new light on this underexplored aspect of Britain's wartime history World in the Balance Brooke C. Dogfight Adam Claasen,2012 This book tells the story of Australians and New Zealanders in one of the Second World War s defining and most memorable campaigns From July until October 1940 the German air force the Luftwaffe sought aerial supremacy in skies over England as a prerequisite for an invasion of Britain Operation Sealion The ensuing conflict of Luftwaffe and RAF aircraft in the long summer of 1940 became forever known as the Battle of Britain Of the 574 overseas pilots in the campaign the New Zealand contingent of 134 airmen was second in size only to the Polish contribution The Australian involvement though smaller was a healthy 37 Thus a fifth of overseas pilots were Anzacs Among these colonials were some of the Battle of Britain s widely admired aces Of the top ten pilots with the greatest number of victories two were New Zealanders C F Gray and B Carbury and one an Australian P Hughes Australian and New Zealand aircrew were also employed in attacking enemy Channel ports and airfields as part of Bomber and Coastal Command s attempts to thwart invasion preparations and blunt the Luftwaffe aerial onslaught The Anzacs also had a fellow compatriot at the highest level in the Fighter Command system the highly regarded New Zealander Air Vice Marshal Sir Keith Park who was instrumental in devising and implementing the integrated air defence of Britain around Spitfire and Hurricane aircraft radio control and radar In the spring of 1940 he was given the command of Group 11 which would face the brunt of the German aggression in south east England The success of Park s plans and operational initiatives and the role played by Anzac pilots and aircrew would all contribute to the conflict s eventual successful outcome
