California Modern , 2002 **Craig Ellwood** Alfonso Pérez-Méndez, 2002 All but forgotten today Craig Ellwood was one of the finest California architects of the postwar era By the time he was thirty he had already contributed three of the seminal Case Study Houses and received the S o Paulo Award for his Courtyard Apartments Subsequently influenced by Mies he went on to design a lengthy series of stark minimalist structures peaking with the Pasadena Art Center a masterpiece among architecture of a Miesian persuasion With the support of John Entenza editor of the influential magazine *Arts Architecture* he was until the late 1960s widely considered as one of the most innovative American architects of the period This book documents all the Ellwood buildings that remain on the records a total of some ninety structures Its 600 illustrations include comprehensive archival photography including Ellwood s own pictures and others by Julius Shulman original drawings and for those buildings that remain in good condition recent images Due to the loss of most of the original drawings 80 floor plans have been redrawn for this publication making this book as close a record of Ellwood s complete works as is possible today Craig Ellwood Craig Ellwood, 2004 With *Craig Ellwood 15 Houses* we start reprinting in hardcover book format the issues of the *2G Architecture Review* that have been out of print Craig Ellwood s career was extensive including over one hundred documented buildings Houses were Ellwood s beginning and the origin of his experimentation And since he designed domestic architecture up to the later years the houses provide a comprehensive view of his career Ellwood s residential work also benefited from the experimentation in his commercial architecture The selection has been marked by the state of conservation of the houses Fortunately the number of them in good shape represent the breadth of Ellwood s career The publication of all this material rather than undermining the tale that Ellwood told of himself demonstrates the high standard he maintained throughout his production Craig Ellwood Clarendon Texas 1922 was one of

Craig Ellwood Ernie Jacks, Nelson Scott Smith, 2024 Through previously unpublished drawings and photographs coupled with correspondence between Craig Ellwood and Ernie Jacks Craig Ellwood Remembering The Thin Man seeks to illuminate a decades long relationship between the two architects Following his tenure with Ellwood as a young man just out of the US Navy Ernie Jacks went on to work for Edward Durrell Stone His surroundings in Fayetteville Arkansas proved fertile ground to teach architecture alongside E Fay Jones at the University of Arkansas and manage his own architecture practice In the years following the conclusion of World War II Craig Ellwood alongside other progressive architects in Southern California pushed for unique architectural solutions meeting the increased demands of home ownership in the postwar years His early career was accelerated by producing three projects for Arts Architecture designing Case Study House s 16 17 and 18 His firm and the size of projects they produced grew from small private homes to large commercial civic and educational buildings before closing in 1977 The title of this book based on Jacks unpublished manuscript The Thin Man Remembering Craig Ellwood written between 1999 2008 recalls as a lecturer at Yale University when Ellwood was referred to as The Thin Man by the students in recognition of his persistent search for lightness in every design solution
