Harness, 2021-04-29 Prominent specialists champion the view that contemporary management of breast or any cancer requires the partnership of physicians nurses social workers and all others whose special training and talents should be integrated for treating the whole patient Here is the book that sets forth the rationale for this nationwide emerging concept and the means for accomplishing it Dealing with total care of the whole patient this new classic text is written by and for surgeons radiation oncologists medical oncologist pathologists radiologists nurses social workers and others involved with the care and management of the patient with breast cancer **Manmade Breast Cancers** Zillah Eisenstein, 2018-08-06 A new understanding of humanity and feminism from the starting point of breast health is the ultimate goal of Zillah Eisenstein's political memoir of her family's experience with breast cancer The well known feminist author argues that politics always needs the personal and that the personal is never enough on its own Her return to the personal side of the political combines the two for a radicalized way of seeing viewing and knowing The author strives to bring together a critique of environmental damage and the health of women's bodies gain perspective on the role race plays as a factor in breast cancers and in political agendas link prevention and treatment and connect individual support and political change Eisenstein was sixteen when her forty five year old mother successfully battled breast cancer Her two sisters Sarah and Giah were in their twenties when they were diagnosed but neither of them survived She received her own diagnosis when she was forty Despite her family history however Eisenstein rejects the simple argument that genes are simply determining rather than liable to influence by external factors She also questions the dominance of the theory that breast cancer is caused by high lifetime exposure to estrogen Instead she views breast cancer as an environmental disease best understood in terms of ecological racial economic and sexual influences on individual women She uses the term manmade to indicate not only industrial carcinogens and other cultural causes but also the male dominated and defined scientific practices of research and treatment In response *Manmade Breast Cancers* offers a retelling of the meaning of breast cancer and a discussion of universal feminist issues about the body The author says she writes to discover a more just globe which will treasure the health of all of our bodies The emotional depth and intellectual breadth of her argument adds new dimensions to how we understand breast cancer **The Journey Beyond Breast Cancer** Virginia M. Building Genetic Medicine Shobita Parthasarathy, 2012-01-13 A comparative study of genetic testing for breast and ovarian cancer in the United States and Britain that shows the importance of national context in the development and use of science and technology even in an era of globalization In *Building Genetic Medicine* Shobita Parthasarathy shows how even in an era of globalization national context is playing an important role in the development and use of genetic technologies Focusing on the development and deployment of genetic testing for breast and ovarian cancer

known as BRCA testing in the United States and Britain Parthasarathy develops a comparative analysis framework in order to investigate how national toolkits shape both regulations and the architectures of technologies and uses this framework to assess the implications of new genetic technologies Parthasarathy argues that differences in the American and British approaches to health care and commercialization of research led to the establishment of different BRCA services in the two countries In Britain the technology was available through the National Health Service as an integrated program of counseling and laboratory analysis and was viewed as a potentially cost effective form of preventive care In the United States although BRCA testing was initially offered by a number of providers one company eventually became the sole provider of a test available to consumers on demand Parthasarathy draws lessons for the future of genetic medicine from these cross national differences and discusses the ways in which comparative case studies can inform policy making efforts in science and technology
