

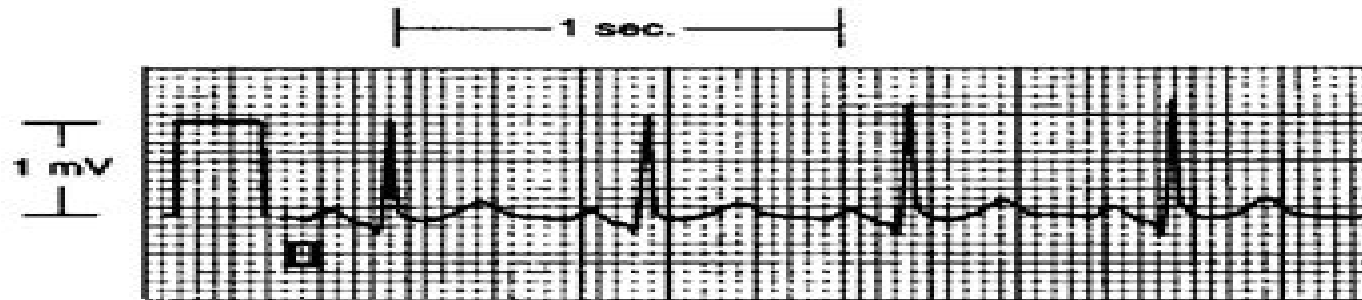


FIGURE 1.1 The square wave at the beginning is a 1-mV calibration marker. At full standard, 10 mm of paper = 1 mV of current. The ECG paper runs at 25 mm/sec. Thus, each millimeter = 0.04 second, and each large square (5 mm) = 0.2 second. The time between two positive deflections, or R waves, is the RR interval. If that is 1 second, the heart rate is 60 beats/min. This patient's heart rate is 100 beats/min (60 seconds per minute ÷ 0.6 second per beat).

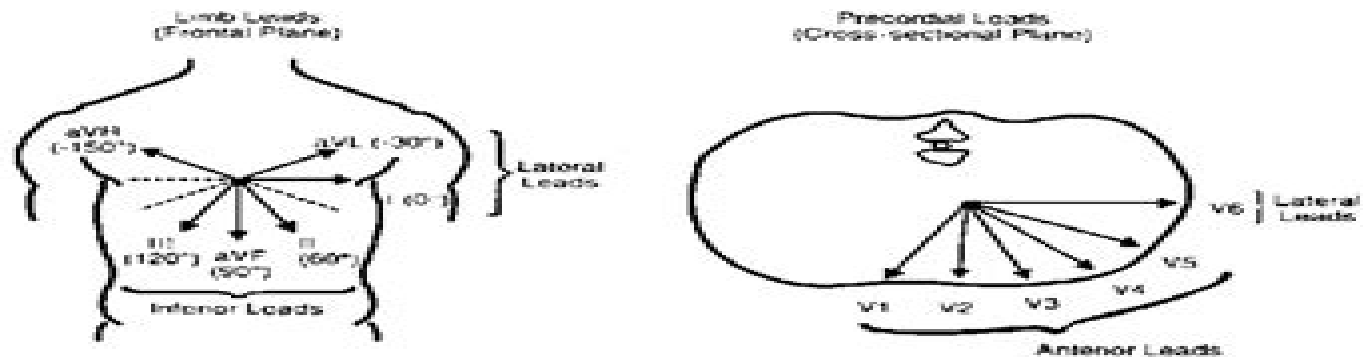


FIGURE 1.2 Spatial orientation of the 12 ECG leads. Each of the ECG leads functions as a voltmeter and has spatial orientation (as voltage is a vector force). Leads that have an inferior orientation are best at detecting changes from the inferior surface of the heart. Anterior precordial leads are most sensitive in detecting anterior wall changes, and the lateral leads, lateral wall abnormalities.
