1759 Frank McLynn, 2008 Although 1759 is not a date as well known in British history as 1215 1588 or 1688 there is a strong case to be made that it is the most significant year since 1066 In 1759 the fourth year of the Seven Years War the British defeated the French in arduous campaigns on four continents and also achieved absolute mastery of the seas Drawing on a mass of primary materials from texts in the Vatican archives to oral histories of the North American Indians Frank McLynn shows how the conflict between Britain and France triggered the first world war raging from Europe to Africa the Caribbean to the Pacific the plains of the Ganges to the Great Lakes of North America It also brought about the War of Independence the acquisition by Britain of the Falkland Islands and ultimately the French Revolution
