The 1920s Scrapbook, 2008 The arts **The 1920s Scrapbook**, 2003 With over 1 000 colourful images Robert Opie brings to life the 1920s and captures the mood of this radical decade in Great Britain The Twenties were a time for change and invention The arrival of the wireless provided a new form of entertainment and The Radio Times was launched in 1923 The popularity of the cinema continued and was changed forever with the coming of talkies and The Jazz Singer in 1926 While there were many notable events from the Tutankhamen discoveries to the Empire exhibition at Wembley unemployment and workers discontent pervaded everyday life culminating in the General Strike of 1926 For children however fun and amusement could be found with new cartoon characters the antics of Felix the Cat at the pictures tales of Pooh Bear in A A Milne's book Winnie the Pooh and in newspapers Bonzo the Dog Daily Sketch Rupert the Bear Daily Express Teddy Tail Daily Mail and Pip Squeak and Wilfred Daily Mirror Apart from women daring to smoke esp. **The Scrapbook in American Life** Susan Tucker, Katherine Ott, Patricia Buckler, 2006 This book explores the history of scrapbook making its origins uses changing forms and purposes as well as the human agents behind the books themselves Scrapbooks bring pleasure in both the making and consuming and are one of the most enduring yet simultaneously changing cultural forms of the last two centuries Despite the popularity of scrapbooks no one has placed them within historical traditions until now This volume considers the makers their artefacts And The viewers within the context of American culture The volume's contributors do not show the reader how to make scrapbooks or improve techniques but instead explore the curious history of what others have done in the past and why these splendid examples of material and visual culture have such a significant place in many households The Weight of Their Votes Lorraine Gates Schuyler, 2008-09-15 After the ratification of the Nineteenth Amendment in 1920 hundreds of thousands of southern women went to the polls for the first time In The Weight of Their Votes Lorraine Gates Schuyler examines the consequences this had in states across the South She shows that from polling places to the halls of state legislatures women altered the political landscape in ways both symbolic and substantive Schuyler challenges popular scholarly opinion that women failed to wield their ballots effectively in the 1920s arguing instead that in state and local politics women made the most of their votes Schuyler explores get out the vote campaigns staged by black and white women in the region and the response of white politicians to the sudden expansion of the electorate Despite the cultural expectations of southern womanhood and the obstacles of poll taxes literacy tests and other suffrage restrictions southern women took advantage of their voting power Schuyler shows Black women mobilized to challenge disfranchisement and seize their right to vote White women lobbied state legislators for policy changes and threatened their representatives with political defeat if they failed to heed women's policy demands Thus even as southern Democrats remained in power the social welfare policies and public spending priorities of southern states changed in the 1920s as a consequence of woman suffrage American Cinema of the 1920s Lucy Fischer, 2009 In ten original essays
