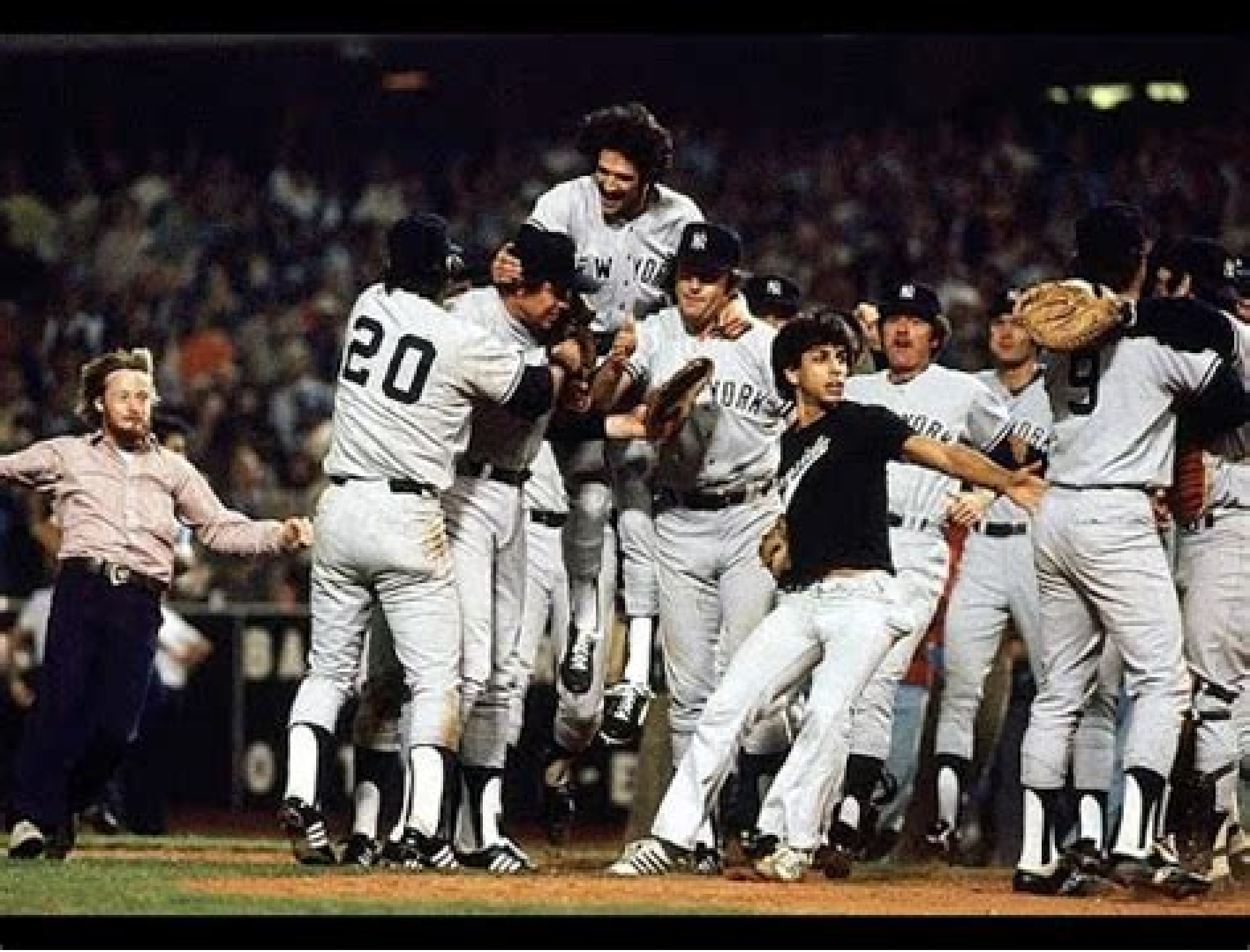

The Pine Tar Game Filip Bondy, 2016-08-02 On July 24 1983 during the finale of a heated four game series between the dynastic New York Yankees and small town Kansas City Royals umpires nullified a go ahead home run based on an obscure rule when Yankees manager Billy Martin pointed out an illegal amount of pine tar the sticky substance used for a better grip on Royals third baseman George Brett's bat Brett wildly charged out of the dugout and chaos ensued The call temporarily cost the Royals the game but the decision was eventually overturned resulting in a resumption of the game several weeks later that created its own hysteria The Pine Tar Game chronicles this watershed moment marking a pivot in the sport when benign cheating tactics like spitballs Superball bats and a couple extra inches of tar on an ash bat gave way to era of soaring salaries labor struggles and rampant use of performance enhancing drugs Filip Bondy paints a portrait of the Yankees and Royals of that era featuring two diametrically opposed owners in George Steinbrenner and Ewing Kauffman a host of bad actors and phenomenal athletes and lots of yelling Players and club officials like Brett Goose Gossage Willie Randolph Ron Guidry Sparky Lyle David Cone and John Schuerholz offer fresh commentary on the events along with their take on a rivalry that culminated in one of the most iconic baseball tantrums of all time Rush Limbaugh employed by the Royals at the time as a promotions director offers his own insider's perspective Through this one fateful game the ensuing protest and ultimate fallout The Pine Tar Game examines a more innocent time in professional sports as well as the shifting tide that gave us today's modern iteration of baseball

Jim Gilliam: The Forgotten Dodger Stephen W. Dittmore, 2025-02-04 This first full length biography of the pioneer covers Jim Junior Gilliam s role during important baseball transitions An established star in the Negro Leagues Gilliam followed Jackie Robinson in MLB s integration efforts As both a Brooklyn Dodger and Los Angeles Dodger Gilliam notched some of the final baseball highlights at Ebbets Field and then served as a face of the new Los Angeles Dodgers Jim Gilliam faced long odds throughout his life and had a knack for overcoming them His father died when he was less than a year old He was raised by his mother in segregated Nashville Tennessee during the Great Depression dropping out of high

school to play ball He rode buses through the Jim Crow south as a member of the Nashville Black Vols and Baltimore Elite Giants Negro Leagues teams in the 1940s He spent two years with the Montreal Royals the Brooklyn Dodgers top minor league team ostensibly because it was easier for the Dodgers to keep mediocre white talent on its big league roster than face the scrutiny of fielding a team with five Black players He persevered to win Rookie of the Year honors as part of a long career in the majors becoming one of MLB s first Black coaches before tragically passing away right before the 1978 World Series On the field Gilliam was truly the bridge between Brooklyn and Los Angeles He recorded the last hit in Brooklyn Dodger history scored a run in the final game at Ebbets Field scored the first Dodger run in both the Los Angeles Coliseum and Dodger Stadium and blasted the first home run in Dodger Stadium He was also a notable bridge between MLB and the Negro Leagues Gilliam is the only player to hit a home run in both the Negro League East West All Star Game 1950 and the Major League All Star Game 1959 and is one of the few players to win both a Negro League Championship and a World Series Gilliam never commanded the spotlight yet was influential in the Dodgers reaching seven World Series winning four during his career He never had a permanent position and was frequently the subject of trade rumors In the meticulously researched and elegantly written Jim Gilliam The Forgotten Dodger Gilliam s life story and its important place in both MLB and Dodgers history is detailed while also providing valuable insights into the racial history of Nashville the Negro Leagues MLB and 1960s Los Angeles Featured are interviews with the Dodgers Gilliam played alongside played for and coached Dick Tracewski Bobby Valentine Peter O Malley Steve Garvey as well as a foreword from former Dodgers GM Fred Claire They Bled Blue Jason Turbow,2019 The wildly entertaining narrative of the outrageous 1981 Dodgers from the award winning author of Dynastic Fantastic Bombastic and The Baseball Codes In the Halberstam tradition of capturing a season through its unforgettable figures They Bled Blue is a sprawling mad tale of excess and exuberance the likes of which could only have occurred in that place at that time That it culminated in an unlikely World Series win during a campaign split by the longest player strike in baseball history is not even the most interesting thing about this team The Dodgers were led by the garrulous Tommy Lasorda part manager part cheerleader who unyieldingly proclaimed devotion to the franchise through monologues about bleeding Dodger blue and worshipping the Big Dodger in the Sky and whose office hosted a regular stream of Hollywood celebrities Steve Garvey the All American All Star first baseman had anchored the most durable infield in major league history and along with Davey Lopes Bill Russell and Ron Cey was glaringly aware that 1981 would represent the end of their run together The season s real story however was one that nobody expected at the outset a chubby lefthander nearly straight out of Mexico twenty years old with a wild delivery and a screwball as his flippin out pitch The Dodgers had been trying for decades to find a Hispanic star to activate the local Mexican population Fernando Valenzuela was the first to succeed and it didn t take long for Fernandomania to sweep far beyond the boundaries of Chavez Ravine They Bled Blue is the rollicking yarn of the Los Angeles Dodgers crazy 1981 season **The Business of Baseball** Albert Theodore
