Orszag, 2002 An examination of U S economic policy in the 1990s by leading policy makers as well as academic economists The 1980's, Decade of Confrontation? , 1981 External shocks, food security, and development Díaz-Bonilla, Eugenio, Piñeiro, Valeria, Elverdin, Pablo, 2016-12-23 We conduct an ex ante evaluation of the impacts of a potential global recession within the next years and the possible policy responses to support economic activity and improve social indicators in five Central American countries Costa Rica El Salvador Guatemala Honduras and Nicaragua We review the economic and social evolution of the past decades in those countries and we consider a global scenario that includes further deceleration of world growth lower commodity prices and a decline in remittances and capital flows to those countries We simulate those scenarios and related policy issues using recursive dynamic CGE models for the countries considered The global shock is run under fixed exchange rates and flexible exchange rates in the case of El Salvador which has adopted the US dollar as the domestic currency the simulation of a flexible exchange rate is just indicative In all cases a flexible exchange rate delivers better results in terms of GDP per capita by softening the overall economic impact of the external shocks Two possible interventions

to deal with the recession are simulated one focuses on policies to strengthen the safety net for the poor the other applies a more general macroeconomic stimulus a tax cut plus a modest increase in public investments financed by un conventional monetary policy to try to cushion the shock For all countries except El Salvador these two simulations are run with a flexible exchange rate In the first policy simulation GDP per capita in those countries does not change much but the poor groups targeted clearly improve their incomes and consumption helping them the most during the years of the negative shocks In the second simulation the macroeconomic stimulus improves the performance of the economies allowing GDP per capita to be higher than in the case of the shock alone In summary facing a potential global downturn as the one simulated here those countries that have flexible exchange rates and the use of domestic monetary policies can use a mix of adjustment in exchange rates combined with targeted poverty transfers and macroeconomic stimulus to alleviate the shock El Salvador which does not have the exchange rate and monetary instruments will require further support from multilateral and bilateral sources to soften the shock

Research Dept.,1989-01-01 Two recent criticisms of summary fiscal indicators are appraised first that they and the conventionally measured public sector balances from which they are derived are not sufficiently broadly defined second that they are meaningless because they do not reflect changes in the distribution of wealth between generations The paper concludes that the defects of summary fiscal indicators have been exaggerated It is not feasible to include all changes in public sector net worth in the deficit and the existence of liquidity constraints and aversion to indebtedness imply that conventionally measured public sector deficits are not irrelevant

Collisionless Shocks in the Heliosphere Robert G. Stone,Bruce T. Tsurutani,1985

Published by the American Geophysical Union as part of the Geophysical Monograph Series Volume 35 Violent expansions of the solar corona cause transient shock waves which propagate outward from the sun at hundreds to thousands of kilometers per second simple solar wind velocity gradients at the surface of the sun lead to high speed streams overtaking slower streams forming corotating shocks and steady state supermagnetosonic solar wind flow past objects such as the planets lead to standing bow shocks However the solar wind plasma is so hot and tenuous that charged particle Coulomb collisions produce negligible thermalization or dissipation on scale sizes less than 0.1 AU The irreversible plasma heating by these shocks is accomplished by wave particle interactions driven by plasma instabilities Hence these shocks are described as collisionless

Four Decades of Terms-of-Trade Booms Gustavo Adler, Mr. Nicolas E. Magud, 2013-05-09 We study the history of terms of trade booms during 1970-2012 with a focus on Latin America through the prisms of a simple metric that quantifies the associated income windfall We also document saving patterns during these episodes and propose a measure of how much of the income windfall was saved We find that Latin America's terms of trade shocks of the last decade have not differed much in magnitude from those observed during the 1970s but that the associated windfall have been substantially larger While aggregate saving increased more than in past episodes the share of the windfall saved the marginal saving rate seems to be lower suggesting that greater aggregate saving reflects mainly the sheer size of the windfall rather than a greater effort to save it Finally we find evidence that while savings during the boom help to increase post boom income the composition of such savings matters Specifically in past episodes savings allocated to foreign asset accumulation appear to have contributed more to post boom income than those devoted to domestic investment

Transmission of Domestic and External Shocks through Input-Output Network: Evidence from Korean Industries Dongyeol Lee, 2019-05-24 In the last two decades manufacturing industries in Korea have become more concentrated and interconnectedness across industries and to foreign countries has risen via vertical relationships and trade linkages This paper investigates the transmission of economic shocks in such a highly concentrated and interconnected structure focusing on the role of vertical and trade linkages and using the industry level international input output data The results suggest that first the role of vertical and trade linkages in propagating growth shocks from both domestic sources and external sources is important Second the growth impact of a few key sources of economic shocks is relatively large These findings highlight that economic shocks in a few key industries and or major trading partners that are transmitted through vertical and trade linkages can lead to large swings in the overall economy This paper contributes to the understanding of the potential interactions between the industrial structure and economic growth and stability

Policies In General Equilibrium Jaime De Melo, 2015-02-26 Policies affecting resource allocation across tradable sectors and those affecting the incentives to produce tradable activities are key determinants of macroeconomic balance and growth. Computable general equilibrium models have made significant contributions to both types of policies. With advancements in computing power and software, these models have become easy to implement and are now widespread. The question then is when and how to formulate them to avoid the black box syndrome. This book seeks to address these issues through carefully selected essays that analyse how to model general equilibrium linkages in a single economy across developing and developed economies and across both micro and macro policies. Micro policies examined include tariffs, quotas and VERs, the choice of taxes to maximize government revenue, migration and remittances and the political economy of tariff setting. Applications on macro policies cover capital inflows, real exchange rate determination and the modeling of the effects of adjustment policies on income distribution. Examples in this book lay out the theoretical foundations alongside a variety of applications to help formulate coherent and transparent models for policy analysis. Archetype economies are extensively used to show how differences in economic structure influence the effects of policies. Graduate students and policy analysts interested in modeling will find this a useful compendium of studies.
