Scharff, 2002-06-20 This 1996 book provides a detailed systematic reconsideration of Auguste Comte Auguste Comte and Positivism Auguste Comte, Although Auguste Comte is conventionally acknowledged as one of the founders of sociology and as a key representative of positivism few new editions of his writings have been published in the English language in this century He has become virtually dissociated from the history of modern positivism and the most recent debates about it Gertrud Lenzer maintains that the work of Comte is for better or for worse essential to an understanding of the modern period of positivism Three significant additions have been made to this edition a new introduction by the editor a new postscript taken from the twelfth Auguste Comte Memorial Trust Lecture also by the editor as well as Comte's Conclusion of the Whole Work of the System of Positive Polity taken from the fourth volume of his seminal work Auguste Comte: Volume 3 Mary Pickering, 2009-09-14 This volume continues to explore the life and works of Auguste Comte during his so called second career It covers the period from the coup d'état of Louis Napoleon in late 1851 to Comte's death in 1857 During these early years of the Second Empire Comte became increasingly conservative and anxious to control his disciples This study offers the first study of the tensions within his movement Focusing on his second masterpiece the *Système de politique positive* and other important books such as the *Synthèse subjective* Mary Pickering not only sheds light on Comte's intellectual development but also traces the dissemination of positivism and the Religion of Humanity throughout many parts of the world **The New Century** Keith Ansell-Pearson, Alan D. Scharff, 2014-02-03 In recent decades widespread rejection of positivism's notorious hostility toward the philosophical tradition has led to renewed debate about the real relationship of philosophy to its history How History Matters to Philosophy takes a fresh look at this debate Current discussion usually starts with the question of whether philosophy's past should matter but Scharff argues that the very existence of the debate itself demonstrates that it already does matter After an introductory review of the recent literature he develops his case in two parts In Part One he shows how history actually matters for even Plato's Socrates Descartes and Comte in spite of their apparent promotion of conspicuously ahistorical Platonic Cartesian and Positivistic ideals In Part Two Scharff argues that the real issue is not whether history matters rather it is that we already have a history a very distinctive and unavoidable inheritance which paradoxically teaches us that history's mattering is merely optional Through interpretations of Dilthey Nietzsche and Heidegger he describes what thinking in a historically determinate way actually involves and he considers how to avoid the denial of this condition that our own philosophical inheritance still seems to expect of us In a brief conclusion Scharff explains how this book should be read as part of his own effort to acknowledge this condition rather than deny it
