Ecological concepts change somewhat over time based on new findings and/or on new interpretations of old data. The distribution and abundance of organisms on Earth is shaped by both **biotic** and **abiotic** factors. Ecology is studied at many levels, including organism, population, community, ecosystem, and biosphere.
