Ecology is the study of the environment, and helps us understand how organisms live with each other in unique physical environments. Ecology is that part of biology that examines the abundance and distribution of organisms, and the interrelationships between organisms and their environment. Ecologists seek to utilize existing and new information to understand and preserve the ability of Earth to sustain all forms of life (including humans). Ecological concepts change somewhat over time based on new findings and/or on new interpretations of old data. The distribution and abundance of organisms on Earth is shaped by both **biotic** and **abiotic** factors. Ecology is studied at many levels, including organism, population, community, ecosystem, and biosphere.
