Else, 1986-07-25 This volume presents a comprehensive review of the current research in the field of primate thinking learning and behavioural development Recent theories of the ways in which primates perceive their world are integrated with the ways that they behave and communicate about each other and their environment Many different species in both the wild and in captivity are discussed with coverage from the social development of neonates to the behaviour of adults The common theme to the contributions is an attempt to understand how primates perceive learn about and manipulate their social and physical environment *Primate Paradigms* Linda Marie Fedigan, 1992-06 This critical review of behavior patterns in nonhuman primates is an excellent study of the importance of female roles in different social groups and their significance in the evolution of human social life A book that properly illuminates in rich detail not only developmental and socioecological aspects of primate behavior but also how and why certain questions are asked In addition the book frequently focuses on insufficiently answered questions especially those concerned with the evolution of primate sex differences Fedigan's book is unique because it places primate adaptations and our explanation of those patterns in a larger intellectual framework that is easily and appropriately connected to many lines of research in different fields sociology psychology anthropology neurobiology endocrinology and biology and not in inconsequential ways either James McKenna *American Journal of Primatology* This is the feminist critique of theories of primate and human evolution John H Cook *Nature*

Social Fabrics of the Mind Michael R.A. Chance, 2015-06-19 Originally published in 1988 this book outlines a new evolutionary paradigm for understanding human society and mental structure originating from the editor's work in primate ethology It is supported and further elaborated by the contributors Chance argues that two modes of social interaction the agonistic and hedonic underlie social life and corresponding mentality In the agonistic mode we are concerned with self security and our attention is much taken up with being accepted by a group This mode is based on a recently discovered state of inhibited braked mental arousal Social behaviour is either authoritarian or authority subservient and has a tendency to control or be controlled It curbs intelligence and restricts personality development In the hedonic mode we are freer to form a network of personal relationships that are typically mutually supportive The hedonic mode leads to the development of self confidence and a relaxed empathic and collaborative personality with intelligence enhanced The volume will still be of interest to all concerned with human affairs including those working in ethology primatology anthropology social psychology psychiatry and political sociology *Interdisciplinary Perspectives and Advances in Understanding Adaptive Memory* Michael Togli, Henry Otgaar, Jeanette Altarriba, William Erickson, 2024-09-11 *Interdisciplinary Perspectives and Advances in Understanding Adaptive Memory* presents the latest theories and research on what is known about adaptive memory often referred to as survival memory Conceptually this is the study of memory systems that evolved to aid remembering survival

Copyright Office,1978 **Human Evolution** ,1986 The Evolution of Evil Timothy Anders,1994 For all its beauty and splendor the world is replete with suffering hardship and misery Why does evil exist Is evil necessary Can we ever hope to abolish evil Philosophers theologians scientists and laypeople have often pondered these questions but their answers have generally been unconvincing or unhelpful They have sometimes tried vainly to show that all evil is really for the best and sometimes to dismiss the problem of evil as too profound to be answered In The Evolution of Evil Timothy Anders offers an original and persuasive solution to the Problem of Evil one that is grounded in science According to Anders the root of all human suffering and hence of all evil is to be found in the historical process by which human life was created evolution by natural selection The compelling simplicity of this explanation has been overlooked because of several widely held misconceptions notably the view that evolution favors the good and eliminates the bad or that evolution favors an inexorable ascent to higher more intelligent and more complex forms At the heart of these misconceptions lie prejudices such as anthropocentrism the view that humankind is the point of the universe and that things therefore tend to be arranged for humanity s benefit the assumption that nature is essentially benevolent toward humans and political utopianism which proclaims that it is possible to bring about a perfect or nearly perfect society Anders exposes the roots of evil in humankind s biological background showing that evolution is not benevolent or progressive and that it tends to lead to suffering which can sometimes be mitigated but never entirely banished Our primate ancestry has left us with many scars of evolution inefficient components which lead to pain and disappointment Anders shows that humans are especially poorly adapted to their environment The fact that they rely heavily on culture and intelligence is not an unmixed blessing
