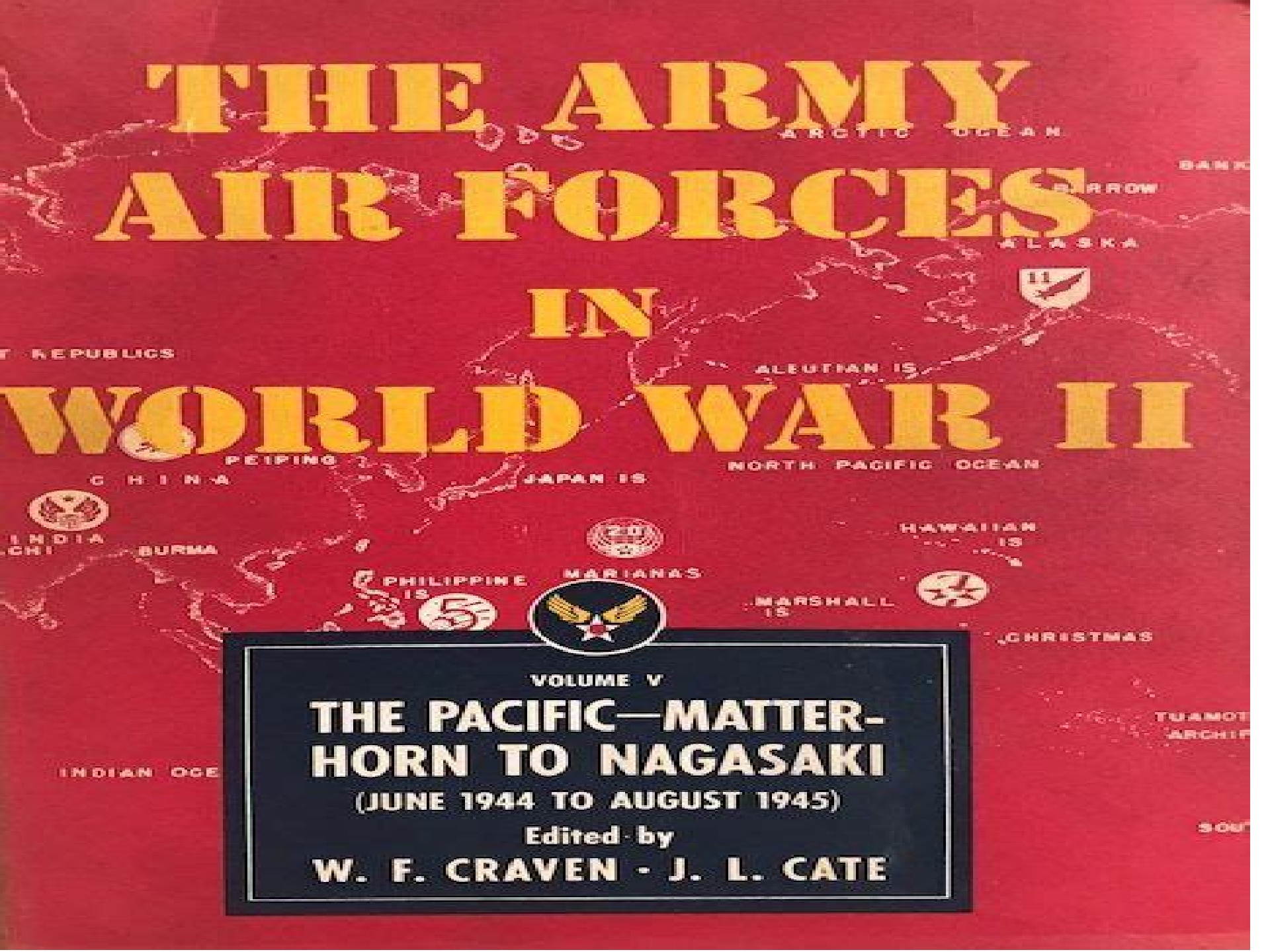

Air Power History Sebastian Cox, Peter Gray, 2013-11-05 The 20th century saw air power transformed from novelists' fantasy into stark reality. From string and canvas to precision weaponry and stealth, air power has progressed to become not only the weapon of first political choice but often the only conceivable option. This rapid development has given rise to considerable debate and controversy with those holding entrenched views rarely slow to shout their case. Many myths have grown over the period ranging from the once much vaunted ability of air power to win wars alone through to its impact as a coercive tool. This volume examines the theory and practice of air power from its earliest inception. The contributors have been drawn from academia and the military and represent some of the world's leading proponents on the subject. All significant eras of air power employment are examined; some are evidently turning points while others represent continuous development. Perhaps more importantly, the book highlights the areas that could be considered to be significant and invites the reader to enter the debate as to whether it constitutes a continuum, a turning point or indeed a revolution.

Allies against the Rising Sun Nicholas Evan Sarantakes, 2009-10-27 In the annals of World War II the role of America's British allies in the Pacific Theater has been largely ignored. Nicholas Sarantakes now revisits this seldom studied chapter to depict the delicate dance among uneasy partners in their fight against Japan, offering the most detailed assessment ever published of the U.S. alliance with Great Britain, Australia, New Zealand, and Canada. Sarantakes examines Britain's motivations for participating in the invasion of Japan, the roles envisioned by its Commonwealth nations and the United States, the decision to accept their participation. He shows how the interests of all allies were served by maintaining the coalition even in the face of disputes between nations, between civilian and military leaders, and between individual services, and that allied participation despite its diplomatic importance limited the efficiency of final operations against Japan. Sarantakes describes how Churchill favored British-led operations to revive the colonial empire while his generals argued that Britain would be further marginalized if it didn't fight alongside the United States in the assault on Japan's home islands. Meanwhile, Commonwealth partners preoccupied with their own security concerns saw an opportunity to support the mother country in service of their own separatist ambitions. And even though the United States called the shots, it welcomed allies to share the predicted casualties of an invasion. Sarantakes takes readers into the halls of both civil and military power in all five nations to show how policies and actions were debated, contested, and resolved. He not only describes the participation of major heads of state but also brings in lesser-known Commonwealth figures plus a cast of military leaders including General of the Army Douglas MacArthur and Fleet Admiral Chester Nimitz on the American side and Admiral of the Fleet Sir Andrew Cunningham

Burrell, 2011-11-07 In February 1945 some 80 000 U S Marines attacked the heavily defended fortress that the Japanese had constructed on the tiny Pacific island of Iwo Jima Leaders of the Army Air Forces said they needed the airfields there to provide fighter escort for their B 29 bombers At the cost of 28 000 American casualties the 3rd 4th and 5th Marine Divisions dutifully conquered this desolate piece of hell with a determination and sacrifice that have become legendary in the annals of war immortalized in the photograph of six Marines raising the American flag on Mount Suribachi But the Army Air Forces fighter operations on Iwo Jima subsequently proved both unproductive and unnecessary After the fact a number of other justifications were generated to rationalize this tragically expensive battle Ultimately misleading statistics were presented to contend that the number of lives saved by B 29 emergency landings on Iwo Jima outweighed the cost of its capture In *The Ghosts of Iwo Jima* Captain Robert S Burrell masterfully reconsiders the costs of taking Iwo Jima and its role in the war effort His thought provoking analysis also highlights the greater contribution of Iwo Jima's valiant dead They inspired a reverence for the Marine Corps that proved critical to its institutional survival and its embodiment of American national spirit From the 7th War Loan Campaign of 1945 through the flag raising at Ground Zero in 2001 the immortal image of Iwo Jima has become a symbol of American patriotism itself Burrell's searching account of this fabled island conflict will advance our understanding of World War II and its continuing legacy for the twenty first century At last the battle's ghosts may unveil its ultimate and most crucial lessons

Crane, 2000 The Korean War was the first armed engagement for the newly formed U S Air Force but far from the type of conflict it expected or wanted to fight As the first air war of the nuclear age it posed a major challenge to the service to define and successfully carry out its mission by stretching the constraints of limited war while avoiding the excesses of total war Conrad Crane analyzes both the successes and failures of the air force in Korea offering a balanced treatment of how the air war in Korea actually unfolded He examines the Air Force's contention that it could play a decisive role in a non nuclear regional war but shows that the fledgling service was held to unrealistically high expectations based on airpower's performance in World War II despite being constrained by the limited nature of the Korean conflict Crane exposes the tensions and rivalries between services showing that emphasis on strategic bombing came at the expense of air support for ground troops and he tells how interactions between army and air force generals shaped the air force's mission and strategy He also addresses misunderstandings about plans to use nuclear biological and chemical weapons in

the war and includes new information from pilot correspondence about the informal policy of hot pursuit over the Yalu that existed at the end of the war The book considers not only the actual air effort in Korea but also its ramifications The air force doubled in size during the war and used that growth to secure its position in the defense establishment but it wagered its future on its ability to deliver nuclear weapons in a high intensity conflict a position that left it unprepared to fight the next limited war in Vietnam As America observes the fiftieth anniversary of its initial engagement in Korea Crane s book is an important reminder of the lessons learned there And as airpower continues to be a cornerstone of American defense this examination of its uses in Korea provides new insights about the air force s capabilities and limitations *Napalm* Robert M.
