#### **Around Proust:**

Around Proust Richard E. Goodkin, 1991-06-05 A study in obsession Marcel Proust's A la recherche du temps perdu is seemingly a self sufficient universe of remarkable internal consistency and yet is full of complex gargantuan digressions Richard Goodkin follows the dual spirit of the novel through highly suggestive readings of the work in its interactions with music psychoanalysis philosophy and cinema and such literary genres as epic lyric poetry and tragedy In exploring this fascinating intertextual network Goodkin reveals some of Proust's less obvious creative sources and considers his influence on later art forms. The artistic and intellectual entities examined in relation to Proust's novel are extremely diverse coming from periods ranging from antiquity Homer Zeno of Elea to the 1950s Hitchcock and belonging to the cultures of the Greek French German and English speaking worlds In spite of this variety of form and perspective all of these analyses share a common methodology that of digressive reading They explore Proust's novel not only in light of such famous passages as those of the madeleine and the good night kiss but also on the basis of seemingly small details that ultimately take us like the novel itself in unexpected directions Proust's Lesbianism Elisabeth Ladenson, 1999 For decades Elisabeth Ladenson says critics have misread or ignored a crucial element in Marcel Proust's fiction his representation of lesbians Her challenging new book definitively establishes the centrality of lesbianism as sexual obsession and aesthetic model in Proust s vast novel A la recherche du temps perdu Traditional readings of the Recherche have dismissed Proust's Gomorrah his term for women who love other women as a veiled portrayal of the novelist s own homosexuality More recently queer positive rereadings have viewed the novel s treatment of female sexuality as ancillary to its accounts of Sodom and its meditations on time and memory Ladenson instead demonstrates the primacy of lesbianism to the novel showing that Proust's lesbians are the only characters to achieve a plenitude of reciprocated desire The example of Sodom by contrast is characterized by frustrated longing and self loathing She locates the work s paradigm of hermetic relations between women in the self sufficient bond between the narrator's mother and grandmother Ladenson traces Proust's depictions of male and female homosexuality from his early work onward and contextualizes his account of lesbianism in late nineteenth century sexology and early twentieth century thought A vital contribution to the fields of queer theory and of French literature and culture Ladenson's book marks a new stage in Proust studies and provides a fascinating chapter in the history of a literary masterpiece s reception

**Proust's Songbook** Jennifer Rushworth,2024-06-04 In Proust's Songbook Jennifer Rushworth analyzes and theorizes the presence and role of songs in Marcel Proust's novel la recherche du temps perdu In Search of Lost Time Instead of focusing on instrumental music and large scale forms such as symphonies and opera as is common in Proust musical studies Rushworth argues for the centrality of songs and lyrics in Proust's opus Her work analyzes the ways in which the author inserted songs at key turning points in his novel and how he drew inspiration from contemporary composers and theorists of song Rushworth presents detailed readings of five moments of song in la recherche du temps perdu highlighting the songs
