Understanding Media Propaganda in the 21st Century Simon Foley, 2021-09-02 First published in 1988 Herman and Chomsky's *Manufacturing Consent* remains the go to book for those interested in understanding why the mainstream media act as vehicles for power elite propaganda. The analytical heart of *Manufacturing Consent* lies in what it calls The Propaganda Model. According to this model there are five filters which all newsworthy stories have to pass through before reaching the public sphere. However a lot has changed in the subsequent thirty something years. Consequently a key question that needs to be addressed is whether *Manufacturing Consent* is still fit for purpose. The conceit underpinning *Understanding Media Propaganda in the 21st Century* *Manufacturing Consent Revisited and Revised* is that the election of Trump in 2016 constitutes the proverbial year zero for fourth estate journalism. As a result of the journalistic cultural revolution that ensued it argues that the Propaganda Model needs to be overhauled if it is to retain its epistemological bona fides. To this end this book is a radical in the true critical sense of the word. Intervention into the propaganda fake news debate. For students in the broadest sense of the term of media studies journalism communication studies and sociology it provides both a compelling critique of Herman and Chomsky's Propaganda Model while at the same time proffering a new explanatory model to understand why MSM output typically replicates the stenographer for power playbook.

Dutton also makes the case that internet policy interventions across the globe have increased censorship of users and introduced levels of surveillance that will challenge the vitality of the internet and the Fifth Estate along with its more pluralist distribution of power. Barbara Mittler, 2020-03-23 In 1872 in the treaty port of Shanghai British merchant Ernest Major founded one of the longest lived and most successful of modern Chinese language newspapers the Shenbao His publication quickly became a leading newspaper in China and won praise as a department store of news a forum for intellectual discussion and moral challenge and an independent mouthpiece of the public voice Located in the International Settlement of Shanghai it was free of government regulation Paradoxically in a country where the government monopolized the public sphere it became one of the world s most independent newspapers As a private venture the Shenbao was free of the ideologies that constrained missionary papers published in China during the nineteenth century But it also lacked the subsidies that allowed these papers to survive without a large readership As a purely commercial venture the foreign managed Shenbao depended on the acceptance of educated Chinese who would write for it read it and buy it This book sets out to analyze how the managers of the Shenbao made their alien product acceptable to Chinese readers and how foreign style newspapers became alternative modes of communication acknowledged as a powerful part of the Chinese public sphere within a few years In short it describes how the foreign Shenbao became a newspaper for China

Edith could surely contribute a valuable study for the celebration. It is no surprise that in view of her circumstances she discovered in the subject of the cross a central viewpoint for her study. A subject like this enabled her to grasp John's unity of being as expressed in his life and works. Using her training in phenomenology she helps the reader apprehend the difference in the symbolic character of cross and night and why the night symbol prevails in John. She clarifies that detachment is designated by him as a night through which the soul must pass to reach union with God and points out how entering the night is equivalent to carrying the cross. Finally in a fascinating way Edith speaks of how the heart or fountainhead of personal life, an inmost region, is present in both God and the soul and that in the spiritual marriage this inmost region is surrendered by each to the other. She observes that in the soul seized by God in contemplation all that is mortal is consumed in the fire of eternal love. The spirit, as spirit, is destined for immortal being to move through fire along a path from the cross of Christ to the glory of his resurrection. Book includes two photos and fully linked index.

Its framers cannot perceive minute distinctions which arise in the progress of the nation and therefore confine it to the establishment of broad and general principles. But were these broad and general principles themselves fixed. For Webster there were landmarks: the Contract Clause and the Commerce Clause. While others were exploring and surveying the Northwest Territory and the Louisiana Purchase, Webster set out to map the spaces in the constitutional and legal landscape that were unmarked.
