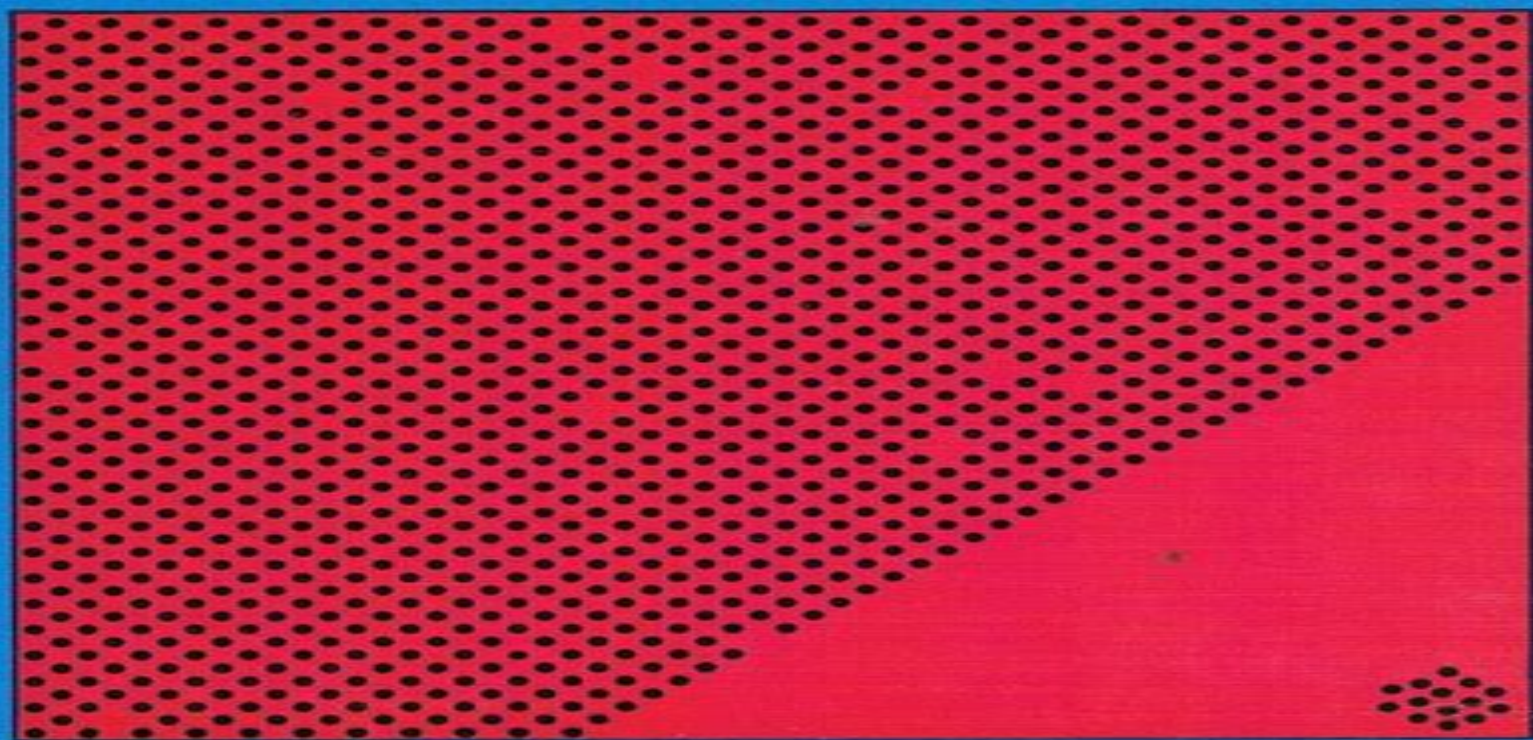

Gay Men and the Left in Post-war Britain Lucy Robinson, 2013-07-19 Available in paperback for the first time his book demonstrates how the personal became political in post war Britain and argues that attention to gay activism can help us to fundamentally rethink the nature of post war politics While the Left were fighting among themselves and the reformists were struggling with the limits of law reform gay men started organising for themselves first individually within existing organisations and later rejecting formal political structures altogether Culture performance and identity took over from economics and class struggle as gay men worked to change the world through the politics of sexuality Throughout the post war years the new cult of the teenager in the 1950s CND and the counter culture of the 1960s gay liberation feminism the Punk movement and the miners strike of 1984 all helped to build a politics of identity There is an assumption among many of today s politicians that young people are apathetic and disengaged This book argues that these politicians are looking in the wrong place People now feel that they can impact the world through the way in which they live shop have sex and organise their private lives Robinson shows that gay men and their politics have been central to this change in the post war world

Charisma and Social Structure Raymond Trevor Bradley, 1998 The author states in his preface Despite charisma s growing importance social science has made little progress in unraveling the enigma of charisma beyond that achieved by Max Weber over half a century ago The results of the research reported in this book offer what I believe is a new and fruitful understanding of charisma As Karl H Pribram says in his Foreword Bradley comes off as a superb scientist Convinced that the common idea that charisma is mainly the leadership quality of an exceptional individual Bradley believes that charisma occurs because of the nature and dynamics of certain groups Much of his research is based on the study of communes in the 1970 s The results of the research reported in this landmark book offer important insights into our understanding of charisma The relational

forms that provide charisma with its power for radical social transformation within a group a hierarchy of communion and a hierarchy of power are what account for the stability of charismatic groups Evidence suggests a similar interrelationship holds for noncharismatic systems This book is for sociologists and psychologists and also for researchers political opinion makers advertisers managers and anyone interested in the invisible workings of human power love and communication

Scottish Gods Bruce Steve Bruce, 2018-09-17 Steve Bruce here presents a highly readable account of the changing nature and place of religion in Scotland in an increasingly irreligious society In 1900 Scotland was a largely Presbyterian country and the Christian churches were a major social force Now less than 10 per cent of Scots attend church As religion has declined it has become more varied Catholicism has grown as have Charismatic Christian fellowships Buddhist and Hindu themes have easternised our religious vocabulary a significant Muslim population has become established and a notable number of Scots now pursue personal spiritual interests in forms which would once have been dismissed as pagan Both this decline and the diversification deserve explanation The Protestant Catholic divide has faded but Scots have new controversies over the proper public place of religion in the light of growing secularization and diversification The growth of individual liberty and increasing cultural diversity combine to weaken all shared beliefs by changing religion from a social matter into a private personal concern All religious groups are faced with the choice of either accommodating that trend and losing their distinctiveness or resisting it and making membership too costly for most potential adherents This radical remapping of Scotland's religious character is a fascinating summary of a remarkable career of research and analysis by one of Scotland's leading social historians Topics include Lewis Orkney and Shetland compared the integration of the Irish the growth and decline of the Catholic Church Scotland Orange and Protestant the Post War Kirk factionalism in the conservative Presbyterian churches the failure of the charismatic movement in Scotland Samye Ling and Buddhism Findhorn and New Age spirituality Scots Muslims and arguments over the ordination of women and gay rights

interact and the consequences the success or failure of the action and its side effects and by products The final chapter revisits the realm of the general theory of collective behavior seeking new coherent empirically valid insights into the role of the episodic dimension in human behavior Rose brings the subject alive with numerous examples of collective behavior from the panic created by Orson Welles's 1938 Martian invasion broadcast to the eruption of Mount St Helens the Italian earthquake the Miami riots the Attica prison uprising the purges in revolutionary Iran and the growth of religious cults

An Ordered Love Louis J. Kern, 2014-07-01 An Ordered Love is the first detailed study of sex roles in the utopian communities that proposed alternatives to monogamous marriage The Shakers 1779 1890 the Mormons 1843 90 and the Oneida Community 1848 79 The lives of men and women changed substantially when they joined one of the utopian communities Louis J Kern challenges the commonly held belief that Mormon polygamy was uniformly downgrading to women and that Oneida pantagamy and Shaker celibacy were liberating for them Rather Kern asserts that changes in sexual behavior and roles for women occurred in ideological environments that assumed women were inferior and needed male guidance An elemental distrust of women denied the Victorian belief in their moral superiority attacked the sanctity of the maternal role and institutionalized the dominance of men over women These utopias accepted the revolutionary idea that the pleasure bond was the essence of marriage They provided their members with a highly developed theological and ideological position that helped them cope with the ambiguities and anxieties they felt during a difficult transitional stage in social mores Analysis of the theological doctrines of these communities indicates how pervasive sexual questions were in the minds of the utopians and how closely they were related to both reform social perfection and salvation individual perfection These communities saw sex as the point at which the demands of individual selfishness and the social requirements of self sacrifice were in most open conflict They did not offer their members sexual license but rather they established ideals of sexual orderliness and moral stability and sought to provide a refuge from the rampant sexual anxieties of Victorian culture Kern examines the critical importance of considerations of sexuality and sexual behavior in these communities recognizing their value as indications of larger social and cultural tensions Using the insights of history psychology and sociology he investigates the relationships between the individual and society ideology and behavior and thought and action as expressed in the sexual life of these three communities Previously unused manuscript sources on the Oneida Community and Shaker journals and daybooks reveal interesting and sometimes startling information on sexual behavior and attitudes
