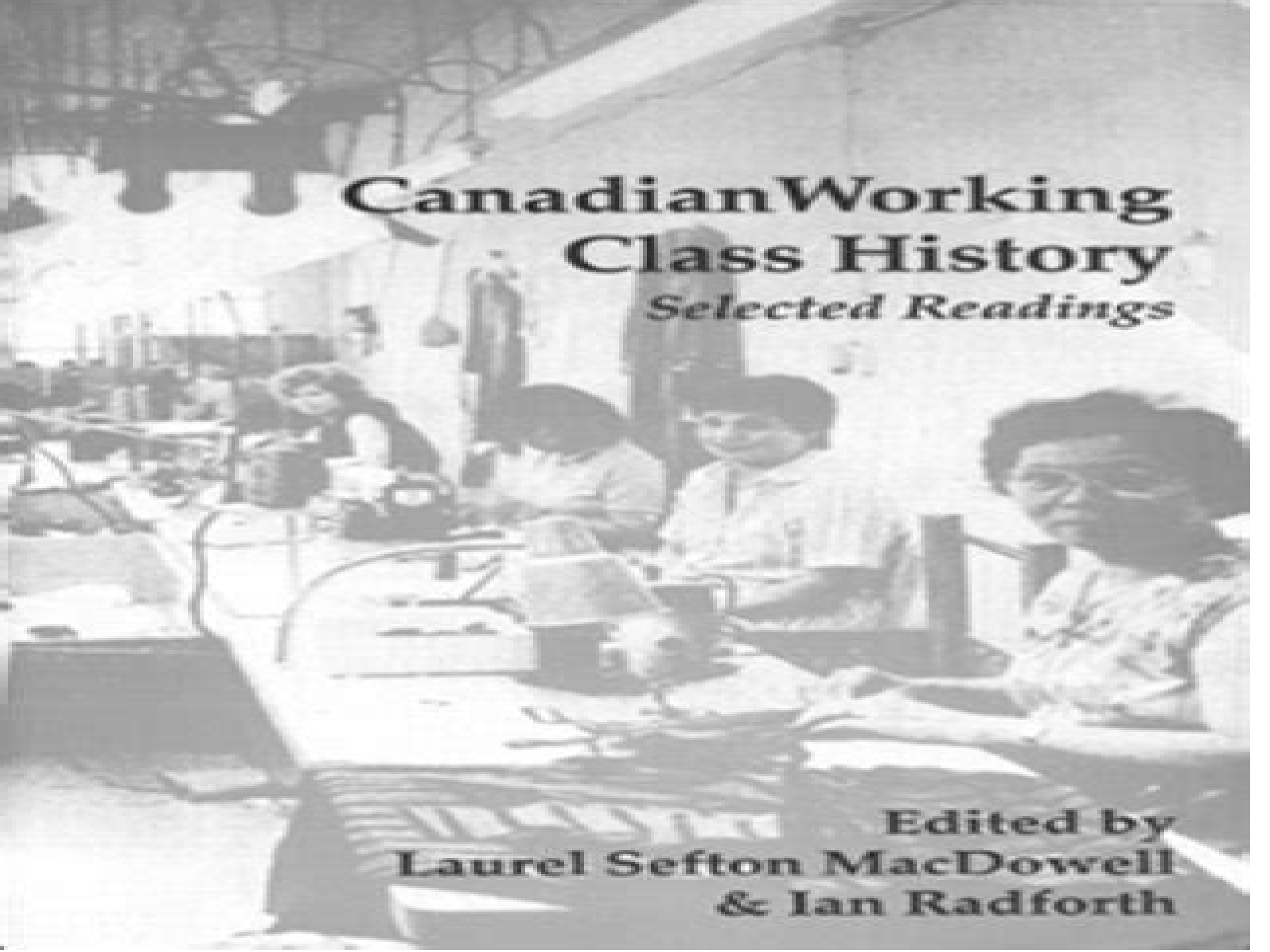

**Canadian Working-class History** Laurel Sefton MacDowell, Ian Walter Radforth, 2006 Canadian Working Class History Selected Readings Third Edition is an updated version of the bestselling reader that brings together recent and classic scholarship on the history politics and social groups of the working class in Canada Some of the changes readers will find in the new edition include better representation of women scholars and nine provocative and ground breaking new articles on racism and human rights women s equality gender history Quebec sovereignty and the environment *The Canadian Labour Movement* Craig Heron, 2020-06-01 In *The Canadian Labour Movement* historian Craig Heron and political scientist Charles Smith tell the story of Canada s workers from the midnineteenth century through to today painting a vivid picture of key developments such as the birth of craft unionism the breakthroughs of the fifties and sixties and the setbacks of the early twenty first century The fourth edition of this book has been completely updated with a substantial new chapter that covers the period from the great recession of 2008 through to 2020 In this chapter Smith describes the fallout of the financial crisis how Stephen Harper s government restricted labour rights the rise of the gig economy and precarious work and the continued de industrialization in the private sector These pressures contributed to fracturing the movement as when Unifor the largest private sector union split from the Canadian Labour Congress the established house of labour Through it all rank and file union members have fought for better conditions for all workers including through campaigns like the fight for a 15 minimum wage *The Canadian Labour Movement* is the definitive book for anyone interested in understanding the origins achievements and challenges of the labour and social justice movements in Canada *Workers and Canadian History* Gregory S. Kealey, 1995 This collection of twelve essays by Gregory Kealey will be of great interest to students and scholars of Canadian history labour history Marxist and socialist theory and history and political science *Labour Goes to War* Wendy Cuthbertson, 2012 During the Second World War the Congress of Industrial Organizations in Canada grew from a handful of members to more than a quarter million and from political insignificance to a position of influence in the emergence of the welfare state What was it about the good war that brought about this phenomenal growth *Labour Goes to War* analyzes the organizing strategies of the CIO during the war to show that both cultural and economic forces were at work Labour shortages gave workers greater power in the workplace and increased their militancy But workers patriotism their ties to those on active service and allegiance to the people s war also contributed to the CIO s growth and to what it claimed for workers Drawing on a wealth of archival material Wendy Cuthbertson illuminates this complex wartime context She also shows how the complex often contradictory motives of workers during this period left the Canadian labour movement with an ambivalent progressive conservative legacy ***The Canadian Labour Movement: A Short History*** Craig Heron, 1996 *The Canadian Labour Movement* is a fascinating story that brings to life the working men and women who built Canada s unions This concise history recounts the story of Canadian labour from the nineteenth century to the present

Smith, 2002 Citizen Docker Andrew Parnaby, 2008-01-01 After the First World War many Canadians were concerned with the possibility of national regeneration Progressive minded politicians academics church leaders and social reformers turned increasingly to the state for solutions Yet as significant as the state was in articulating and instituting a new morality outside actors such as employers were active in pursuing reform agendas as well taking aim at the welfare of the family citizen and nation Citizen Docker considers this trend focusing on the Vancouver waterfront as a case in point After the war waterfront employers embarked on an ambitious program welfare capitalism to ease industrial relations increase the efficiency of the port and ultimately recondition longshoremen themselves Andrew Parnaby considers these reforms as a microcosm of the process of accommodation between labour and capital that affected Canadian society as a whole in the 1920s and 1930s By creating a new sense of entitlement among waterfront workers one that could not be satisfied by employers during the Great Depression welfare capitalism played an important role in the cultural transformation that took place after the Second World War Encompassing labour and gender history aboriginal studies and the study of state formation Citizen Docker examines the deep shift in the aspirations of working people and the implications that shift had on Canadian society in the interwar years and beyond
