A docile civil servant chooses the public baths as the setting for his private Armageddon; a widow's new false nails are the unlikely trigger for her release from pent-up grief; a couple bereft without their beloved dog conjure it into existence; a frustrated Sunday painter devours eleven farmhouse loaves at a sitting. Many of the characters are fighting personal demons: anger, fear, jealousy, obsession, or are torn between submission and murderous revenge. Others are dreamers inhabiting their own secret worlds or forced to come to terms with loss: loss of certainty and security of faith, innocence or freedom. Love goes spectacularly wrong; spouses moving along parallel lines fail to commune; sons defy mothers; mothers mourn lost daughter; lovers are symbolically exterminated. *Demon King's Desire* J.L. *Demonic Desires* Ishay Rosen-Zvi,2011-11-29 In *Demonic Desires* Ishay Rosen Zvi examines the concept of yetzer hara or evil inclination and its evolution in biblical and rabbinic literature Contrary to existing scholarship which reads the term under the rubric of destructive sexual desire Rosen Zvi contends that in late antiquity the yetzer represents a general tendency toward evil Rather than the lower bodily part of a human the rabbinic yetzer is a wicked sophisticated inciter attempting to snare humans to sin The rabbinic yetzer should therefore not be read in the tradition of the Hellenistic quest for control over the lower parts of the psyche writes Rosen Zvi but rather in the tradition of ancient Jewish and Christian demonology Rosen Zvi conducts a systematic and comprehensive analysis of the some one hundred and fifty appearances of the evil yetzer in classical rabbinic literature to explore the biblical and postbiblical search for the sources of human sinfulness By examining the yetzer within a specific demonological tradition *Demonic Desires* places the yetzer discourse in the larger context of a move toward psychologization in late antiquity in which evil and even demons became internalized within the human psyche The book discusses various manifestations of this move in patristic and monastic material from Clement and Origin to Antony Athanasius and Evagrius It concludes with a consideration of the broader implications of the yetzer discourse in rabbinic anthropology
