produced garments called bordados Because the artists who create these beautiful objects are also producers who carve an economic foothold family workshops are vital in a nation where jobs are as scarce as peace But ambiguity permeates all practices shaping bordados significance Femen as traces contemporary political and ritual applications not only Caylloma s long standing and violent ethnic conflicts to the historical importance of cloth since Inca times This is the only book about expressive culture in an Andean nation that centers on gender In this feminist contribution to ethnography based on twenty years experience with Peru including two years of intensive fieldwork Femen as reflects on the ways gender shapes relationships among subjects research and representation
