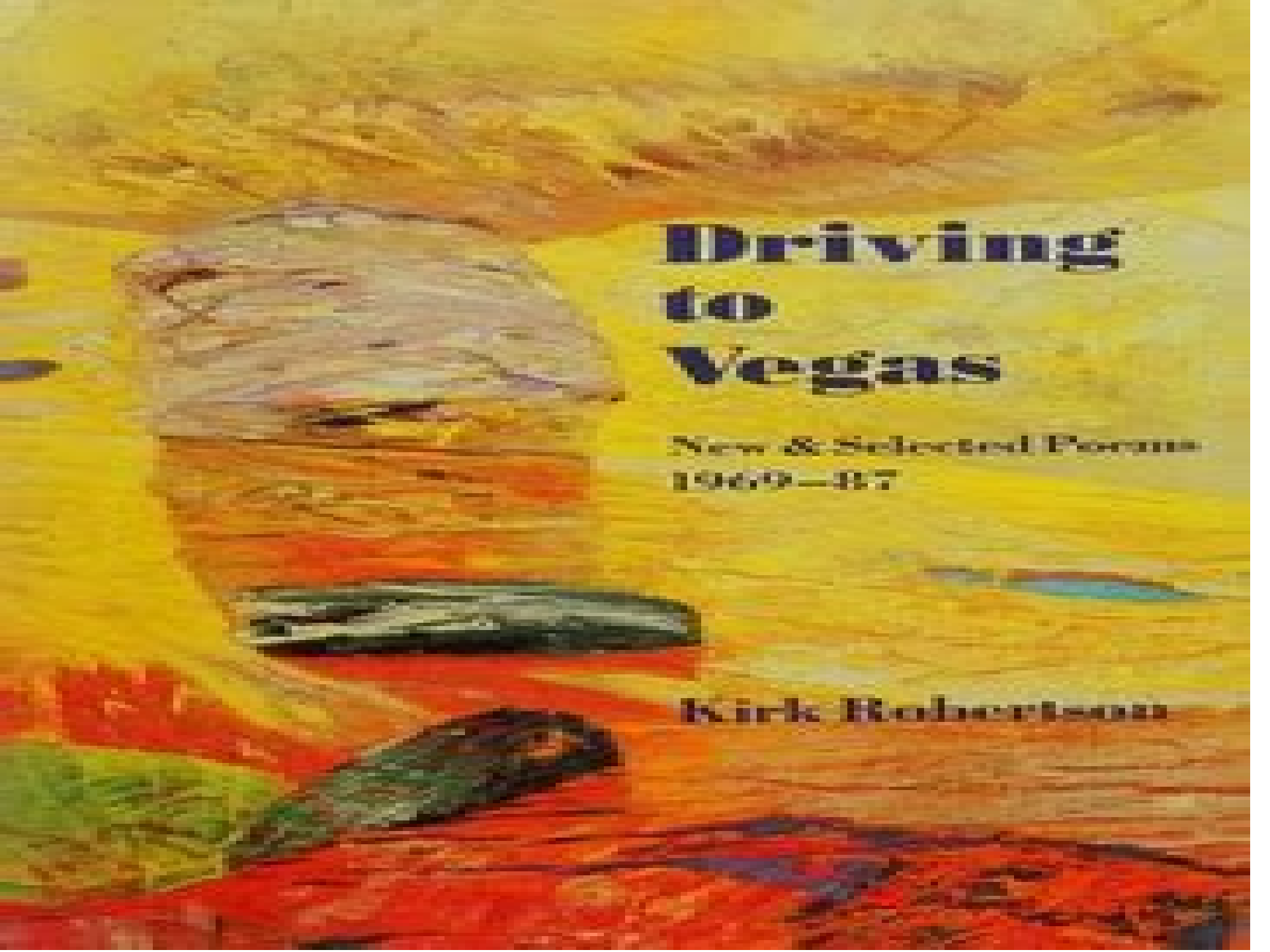

The Broadview Anthology of Poetry - Second Edition Amanda Goldrick-Jones, Herbert Rosengarten, 2008-09-30 Among the poets new to this edition are such leading names as Americans Robert Pinsky Louise Erdrich and Louise Glück Britons James Fenton and Carol Ann Duffy and Canadians Anne Carson Robert Bringhurst and Christian Bok A number of names who may be new to many readers of poetry are also included among them Ohioan Debra Allberry Vancouverite Elise Partridge and the Cree poet Connie Fife as with the first edition the editors have endeavored to include much that is fresh as well as much that is familiar There are many additions to the selections from poets who appeared in the first edition including selections from the recent work of Leonard Cohen Les Murray and Margaret Atwood As before the anthology includes work from English language poets throughout the world from India Africa and the Caribbean as well as from Britain North America and Australia Although the selections from the work of poets of earlier eras are largely unchanged from the first edition there have been some changes among poems added for this edition are Milton's L'Allegro and Il Penseroso Bradstreet's Employment Dickinson's I cannot live without You Frost's Once by the Pacific and Auden's Funeral Blues As before the text emphasizes work of the past century poems from 1900 or later take up more than half of the anthology's pages In its first edition The Broadview Anthology of Poetry included biographical information about the poets at the back of the anthology for the new edition biographical material appears in a headnote to each poet Two other features are also new to this edition the date of first publication is appended after each poem and line numbering is used throughout The numbers have been kept unobtrusive however as with the first edition the designers have endeavored to give a clean look to the pages of the anthology A substantial section on prosody figures of speech and so on is included as an appendix

The Muse in the Machine T. R. Hummer, 2011-08-15

Music race politics and conscience In these eight essays written over the span of a decade and a half T R Hummer explains how for him such abiding concerns revolve around the practice of poetry and the evolution of a culturally responsible personal poetics Hummer writes about the suicide of poet Vachel Lindsay the culture wars at the National Endowment for the Arts the 1991 Persian Gulf War the divided soul of his native American South and the salving transcendent practice of musicianship Inevitably entwined with a personal or cultural component Hummer's criticism is thus grounded in experience that is always familiar and often straight to the heart in its rightness In one of those statements of poetic purpose that goes hand in hand with a residency guest editorship or lecture tour Hummer once wrote that poetry inhabits and enunciates an incommensurable zone between individual and collective between body and body politic an area very ill negotiated by most of us most of the time Our culture

with its emphasis on the individual mind and body teaches us very little about how even to think about the nature of this problem E pluribus unum is a smokescreen what pluribus what unum And yet this phrase is an American mantra as if it explained something This is a quintessential Hummer moment a writer has just given himself a good reason to quit What Hummer knows must happen next is what The Muse in the Machine is all about **Everyday Magic** Laurie

Ricou, 2011-11-01 Child language is a subject in which everyone is an expert All parents study their children's language carefully if undeliberately and every family has its precious memories of the unique verbal improvisations of childhood For writers who continually struggle with and revel in the mysteries of language the language of children holds a special attraction Everyday Magic looks at the way Canadian writers have written through as distinct from for or about children at the ways they have used child language and children's models of perception to achieve various literary effects It describes how texts might be shaped by child usage and speculates that adult artists often find themselves surprised and informed by the child language they seek to create Ricou examines how the distinctive features of child language described by psycholinguists intersect with the written languages used by writers to suggest not only a child language but also the way a child sees and organizes an understanding of the world The book's subtitle putting the term child language into the plural points out that not one but many written interpretations of the child's perspectives are possible In order to emphasize this plurality and indicate that there are any number of child languages the author has organized his study as a series of closely related essays Each chapter considers the work of a Canadian author or authors with the book as a whole moving from the more conventional writers to those who step outside the bounds of convention Ricou proposes analogies with Wordsworth and Dylan Thomas Proust and Dickens but he finds his principal subject in the inherent interest of for example the Piagetian scheme that W O Mitchell seems to adopt in Who Has Seen the Wind the obsessions with similes in Ernest Buckler the variations on the Bildungsroman in Margaret Laurence and Alice Munro and the persistent experiments with presymbolic language in Bill Bissett For these and other writers such as Clark Blaise Emily Carr Dennis Lee Dorothy Livesay P K Page James Reaney and Miriam Waddington Ricou illuminates the particular literary languages appropriate to each author's subject The result is a fascinating and unique approach to Canadian literature **Mentor and Muse** Blas Falconer, Beth
