Schaeper, 1995 This is the first

detailed study account of the life and career of Chaumont whose chief claim to fame was the fact that from 1777 to 1785 Benjamin Franklin lived in his home in the Parisian suburb of Passy Basing his work on documents from two dozen archives in the United States and France Schaeper demonstrates that Chaumont was far more than merely a landlord Prior to the American Revolution he had become one of the most powerful and respected businessmen of the Old Regime For personal as well as patriotic reasons he aided the American insurgents and worked with a wide array of persons In addition to Franklin these included John Adams Silas Deane Caron de Beaumarchais the marquis de Lafayette and the comte de Vergennes Chaumont performed an astounding range of services acting as intermediary an adviser and a supplier of arms and clothing His most dramatic contribution to the American cause involved John Paul Jones It was Chaumont who obtained the famous Bonhomme Richard for the commodore Through looking at the activities of this intriguing individual the author is able to offer many new insights into both American and French history Lively and well written this biography will appeal to both the historian and the general reader *Britain and the Papacy in the Age of Revolution, 1846-1851* Saho Matsumoto-Best, 2003

Britain's support for constitutional government in Italy and anxieties about the Irish Catholic Church brought Britain and the Papacy briefly together From the time of the Reformation Anglo-Vatican relations have typically been seen as a long history of unending antagonism and mutual suspicion but this has not always been the case This book sheds light on one of the most curious episodes in early Victorian history when around the time of the 1848 revolutions in Europe a rapprochement almost

developed between Britain and the papacy and British politicians and writers referred to the new head of the Catholic Church Pius IX as the good pope Integrating diplomatic political ecclesiastical and social history Saho Matsumoto Best traces the factors that brought these two traditionally hostile powers together and the reasons why this rapprochement was doomed to failure She demonstrates how the desire to support constitutional government in Italy and to curb the activities of the Irish Catholic church led the government of Lord John Russell to build a close relationship with Pius IX and how failure to understand the Vatican's priorities and anti papal and anti Catholic feeling in Britain particularly in the context of the restoration of the Catholic hierarchy in 1850 eventually destroyed this policy This study is an important and original contribution to the current debate about the nature of mid nineteenth century Britain and sheds new light on the British role in Italian unification It will also be of great interest to students of nineteenth century European international and ecclesiastical history and of the 1848 revolutions

An Administrative Bureau During the Old Regime Harold Talbot Parker, 1993 This scholarly work throws light on the qualities of the French royal administration during the reign of Louis XVI which was one of the most enduring legacies of the French monarchy to later regimes and on the relations of that administration to the French economy and people In the Controller General's department the Bureau of Commerce was the center of administrative thought about the relations of the French royal government to French industry Through a flow of activity flow of consciousness narrative author Harold T Parker seeks to discover and to communicate how the Bureau's four executive intendants of commerce individually and collegially operated during twenty nine months in routine performance and in the management of two major crises the mass mutiny of most French textile artisans against the Bureau's new textile regulations and the developing surge of British inventions productivity and competitiveness especially in textiles and iron and steel This book thus bears on the nature of the royal administration on the eve of the French Revolution It tends to confirm and illustrate the thesis advanced in other monographs that except in the realm of financing the deficit Louis XVI was a dutiful and reasonably successful administrative monarch He appointed professionals to head his major administrative departments War Army Navy Foreign Affairs and Controller Generalcy He himself did his part in hearing reports and reaching decisions and together with his ministers and their subordinate civil servants he was restoring French strength in the army navy foreign affairs and administrative industrial effort Not only were the four intendants hampered by the two crises in industry but also by the encrusted legal legacy of multitudinous privileges of provinces towns clergy nobles semipublic agencies Farmers General and other ministerial departments Nevertheless in their own minds the intendants thought they were making solid advances toward the development of a balanced French economy The response of the French people it seems varied Between the managers at the center of legal authority and power and the subordinate subjects the relationship was not necessarily one of automatic obedience to royal command Rather there was often a gray zone of stalling and negotiation always with the lurking possibility of successful defiance of any royal order Dr Parker's study is also a quiet

comment on how narrative history ought to be written Most narrative historians purport to represent symbolically what actually happened yet they introduce a degree of narrative order and abstraction that never existed History is actually often meandering and frequently a surprise and the narrative in this book tries to suggest that The account is therefore rich both in what it says and in what it suggests
