The key idea is that constraints such as linear or polynomial equations are used to represent large or even infinite sets in a compact way. The ability to deal with infinite sets makes constraint databases particularly promising as a technology for integrating spatial and temporal data with standard relational databases. Constraint databases bring techniques from a variety of fields such as logic and model theory algebraic and computational geometry as well as symbolic computation to the design and analysis of data models and query languages.
