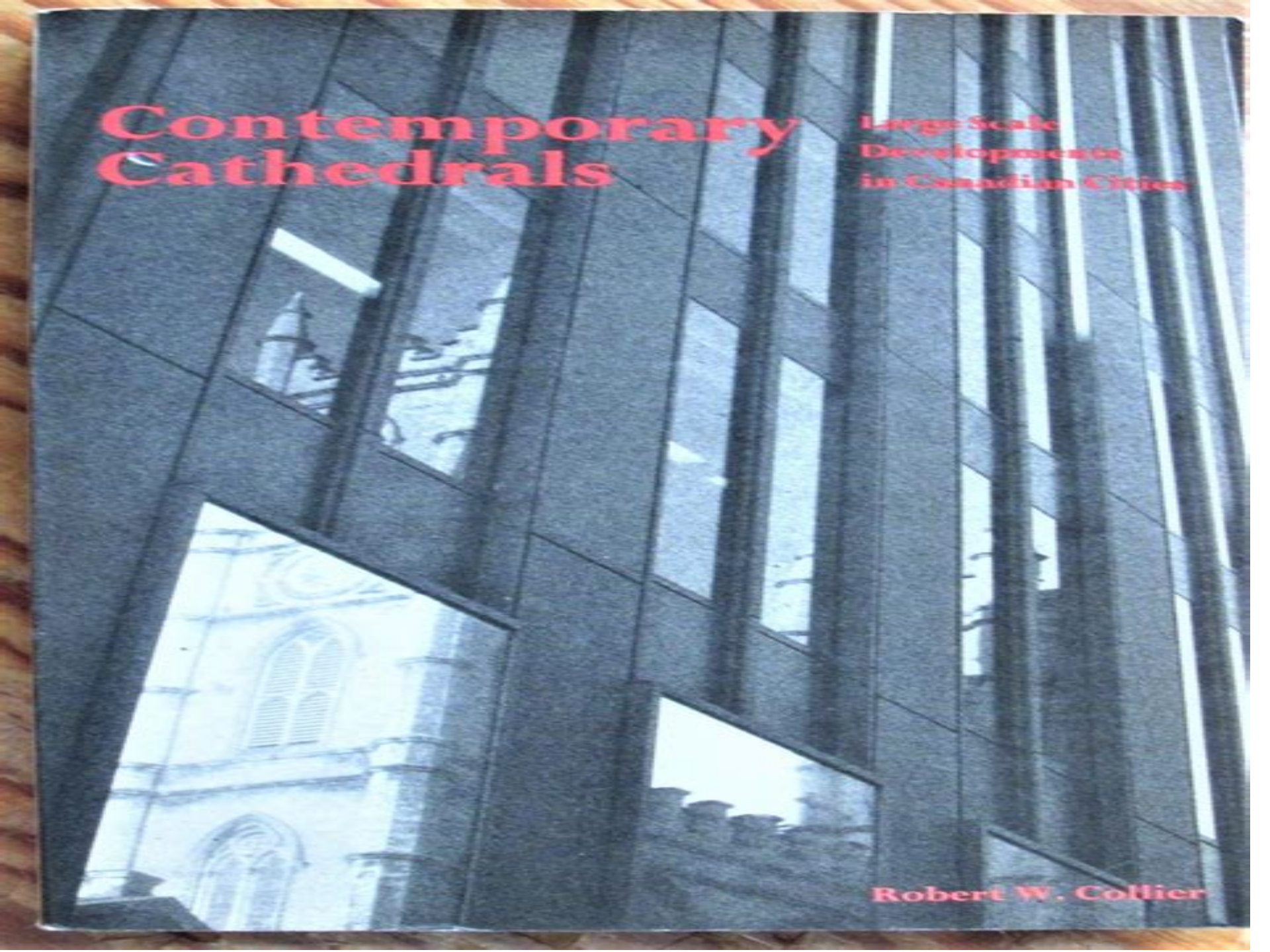

C. Relph, 1987-08 Why do the cities of the late twentieth century look as they do What values do their appearance express and enfold Their sheer scale and the durability of their materials assure that our cities will inform future generations about our era in the same way that gothic cathedrals and medieval squares tell us something of the Middle Ages In the meantime our urban landscapes can tell us much about ourselves For E C Relph the urban landscape must be envisioned as a total environment not just streets and buildings but billboards and parking meters as well The Modern Urban Landscape traces the developments since 1880 in architecture technology planning and society that have formed the visual context of daily life Each of these shaping influences is often viewed in isolation but Relph surveys the ways in which they have operated independently to create what we see when we walk down a street shop in a mall or stare through a windshield on an expressway Two sets of ideas and fashions Relph argues have had

an especially important impact on urban landscapes in the twentieth century An internationalism made possible by new building technologies and more rapid communications has replaced regional style and custom as the dominant feature of city appearance while a firm belief in the merits of self consciousness has imposed logical analysis and technical manipulation on such commonplace objects as curbstones and park benches As a result writes Relph the modern urban landscape is both rationalized and artificial which is another way of saying that it is intensely human **Planning Twentieth Century**

Timothy Cobban,2014-01-31 Cities of Oil is the first sustained historical account of the development of the early Canadian petroleum refining and manufacturing industry In it Timothy W Cobban documents the industry s development in southern Ontario from its beginnings in the 1850s to its later expansion on the outskirts of London to Petrolia and finally to Sarnia He accounts for all of the industry s important developments and innovations particularly the role played by municipalities in fostering its growth Using extensive archival research Cobban concludes that municipalities can stimulate the accelerated sustained development of local industry sectors thus challenging the dominant view that the influence of municipalities on economic growth is marginal Cities of Oil demonstrates the importance of accommodating the land and infrastructure needs of industry at critical junctures and implementing land use policies that encourage the dense clustering of industries This book will be essential reading for those seeking a greater understanding of industrial growth in the province of Ontario

The Way to Go ,1983 This publication examines a variety of cases that demonstrate the aesthetic quality of transportation projects These range from the relatively inexpensive painted Gus Bus in Grand Rapids to the large scale project of designing the Montreal Metro The purpose is to develop a fresh perspective on ways the visual appeal of transportation can be identified as a distinct element for consideration and on the degree to which quality design contributes to the economics and function of transportation systems A second purpose is to develop guidance and examples to assist transportation planners and citizens in dealing with these issues The projects presented represent a wide range of costs and circumstances encountered in transportation planning The study shows that the aesthetic benefits provided by quality materials sensitive design careful maintenance and appropriate inclusion of works of art translate directly into increased patronage cost efficiencies and a better public environment

At the Wilderness Edge J.I. Little,2019-02-28 Vancouver prides itself on being a green city and the west coast is known for its active environmental protest culture But the roots of this mentality reach far beyond the founding of organizations such as Greenpeace Small campaigns led by local community groups from the 1960s onward left a lasting impact on the region At the Wilderness Edge examines five antidevelopment campaigns in and around Vancouver that reflected a dramatic decline in public support for large scale commercial and industrial projects J I Little describes the highly effective protests that were instrumental in preserving threatened green spaces on Coal Harbour Hollyburn Ridge Bowen Island Gambier Island and the Squamish estuary keeping these important British Columbia landmarks from becoming a high rise development project a downhill ski resort a suburban housing tract an open pit copper mine and a major coal port respectively Through detailed analysis of development proposals and protests government studies and community responses Little argues that it was not the usual suspects 1960s radicalism
