

Content Analysis of Dreams and Waking Narratives

This study investigated the specificity of dream content and its continuity with waking life. For each subject (125 men and 125 women, between the ages of 19 and 29 years), a dream and a waking episode were collected according to “the most recent dream” method (Hartmann, Elkin, & Garg, 1991), which was also applied to “a recent life episode.” Both kinds of narratives were analyzed through the application of the Hall–Van de Castle System (1966) and a typical content analysis (a compendium of the most important typical dream taxonomies). In dreams, typical situations involved the dreamer trying to perform some physical action, most frequently with difficulties in mastering the task. Affective relationships and hostile interactions with an enemy were shared by both narratives, but cognitive activities were uncommon in both cases.

AFFECTIVE SYMBOLIZATION

This research aimed at detecting the typical content of dreams in comparison with that of waking life. Continuity and discontinuity between dreams and waking life can be considered by different aspects. The presence in dreams of certain content (e.g., characters, actions, situations) from the dreamer’s waking daily life can be investigated, and the direct correspondence and the coherence between dream content and daily events may be explored. Continuity versus discontinuity can also be considered through the systems of representations in dreams and waking life (i.e., imaginative thought, metaphors, bizarreness; Domhoff, 2002; Hobson, 1988; Schwartz, 2004; Solms, 1997; Strauch & Meier, 1996; Williams, Merritt, Rittenhouse, & Hobson, 1992). Some dream features seem straight from waking life, and some others seem more specific to dreams: “The information available to date suggests that some unusual elements in a dream series probably have figurative meaning, but that many others do not” (Domhoff, 2007, p. 3).

Dreams are not only thoughts expressed by images, but rather they are *emotional thoughts*; they are a system of affective symbolization, basically different from the cognitive system, that works through analogical, sensorial, visceral, and cinestetical codes, expressions of an *affective consciousness* (Bucci, 1997; Fosshage,

Viney, 2012-12-06 The psychological states of patients with diabetes mellitus were compared with those of patients suffering from other chronic diseases and people with no diagnosed chronic diseases. These states were assessed by applying content analysis scales to transcripts of their descriptions of their current experiences. Analyses of the diabetics' scale scores revealed a pattern characterized by much anxiety, depression, anger expressed both directly and indirectly together with feelings of helplessness. The sources of anxiety which proved to be of most importance to them were fears of death and bodily mutilation as well as guilt and shame. They experienced little sense of sharing with most people around them although they showed considerable enjoyment of close relationships with family and friends. This pattern of psychological states did not vary with the sex of the patients or whether they were interviewed in a hospital or at home nor with recency of onset or multiplicity of health problems. It was similar to the pattern of patients with other chronic diseases but differed significantly from that of the healthy group.
