Understood in this way, addiction includes substance abuse as well as behavioral compulsions like excessive gambling or even uncontrollable shopping. However, the specific question it seeks to answer is: What part does cognition, the desires we pursue, and the beliefs we have about how to accomplish them play in explaining addictive behavior? It applies the Behavioral Perspective Model (BPM) of consumer choice, a tried and tested theory of more routine consumption ranging from everyday product and brand choice through credit purchasing and environmental despoliation to the more extreme aspects of consumption represented by compulsion and addiction.
