tales of palace intrigue will fascinate a wide variety of readers The History of Art in Sui, Tang and Five Dynasties Li Shi, The book is the volume of The History of Art in Sui Tang and Five Dynasties among a series of books of Deep into China Histories The earliest known written records of the history of China date from as early as 1250 BC from the Shang dynasty c 1600 1046 BC and the Bamboo Annals 296 BC describe a Xia dynasty c 2070 1600 BC before the Shang but no writing is known from the period The Shang ruled in the Yellow River valley which is commonly held to be the cradle of Chinese civilization However Neolithic civilizations originated at various cultural centers along both the Yellow River and Yangtze River These Yellow River and Yangtze civilizations arose millennia before the Shang With thousands of years of continuous history China is one of the world's oldest civilizations and is regarded as one of the cradles of civilization The Zhou dynasty 1046 256 BC supplanted the Shang and introduced the concept of the Mandate of Heaven to justify their rule The central Zhou government began to weaken due to external and internal pressures in the 8th century BC and the country eventually splintered into smaller states during the Spring and Autumn period These states became independent and warred with one another in the following Warring States period Much of traditional Chinese culture literature and philosophy first developed during those troubled times In 221 BC Qin Shi Huang conguered the various warring states and created for himself the title of Huangdi or emperor of the Oin marking the beginning of imperial China However the oppressive government fell soon after his death and was supplanted by the longer lived Han dynasty 206 BC 220 AD Successive dynasties developed bureaucratic systems that enabled the emperor to control vast territories directly In the 21 centuries from 206 BC until AD 1912 routine administrative tasks were handled by a special elite of scholar officials Young men well versed in calligraphy history literature and philosophy were carefully selected through difficult government examinations China's last dynasty was the Qing 1644 1912 which was replaced by the Republic of China in 1912 and in the mainland by the People's Republic of China in 1949 Chinese history has alternated between periods of political unity and peace and periods of war and failed statehood the most recent being the Chinese Civil War 1927 1949 China was occasionally dominated by steppe peoples most of whom were eventually assimilated into the Han Chinese culture and population Between eras of multiple kingdoms and warlordism Chinese dynasties have ruled parts or all of China in some eras control stretched as far as Xinjiang and Tibet as at present Traditional culture and influences from other parts of Asia and the Western world carried by waves of immigration cultural assimilation expansion and foreign contact form the basis of the modern culture of China Semiotics for Art History Lian Duan, 2018-12-02 Reading art from a semiotic perspective this book offers a new interpretation of the development of Chinese landscape painting and outlines a new framework for contemporary semiotics and critical theory It will appeal to those interested in visual art Chinese studies critical theory semiotics and other relevant fields and will allow the reader to learn how to put theory into the practice of studying art how to give new life to an important theory and how to acquire a new point of view in appreciating and enjoying art with a certain critical theory **Art in China** Craig
