Regulating from Nowhere Douglas A. Kysar, 2010-06-22 Drawing insight from a diverse array of sources including moral philosophy, political theory, cognitive psychology, ecology and science and technology studies, Douglas Kysar offers a new theoretical basis for understanding environmental law and policy. He exposes a critical flaw in the dominant policy paradigm of risk assessment and cost-benefit analysis which asks policymakers to, in essence, regulate from nowhere. Consensus as Democracy in Africa Bernard Matolino, 2018-12-28 Some philosophers on the African continent and beyond are convinced that consensus as a polity represents the best chance for Africa to fully democratise. In *Consensus as Democracy in Africa*, Bernard Matolino challenges the basic assumptions built into consensus as a social and political theory.
