Contours of Canadian Thought A.B. McKillop, 1987-12-15 The leaps of knowledge in nineteenth century science shook the foundations of religious and humanistic values throughout much of the world The Darwinian Revolution and similar developments presented enormous philosophical challenges to Canadian scientists philosophers and men of letters Their responses many and varied form a central theme in this collection of essays by one of Canada's leading intellectual historians McKillop explores the thought of a number of English Canadian thinkers from the 1860s to the 1920s decades that saw Canada's entry into the modern age We meet Daniel Wilson an educator and ethnologist for whom the pursuit of science was a form of poetic engagement requiring the poet's sensibilities John Watson one of the world's leading exponents of objective idealism whose philosophical premises helped to undermine the very religious tradition he sought to bolster and William Dawson LeSueur an apostle of Positivism whose spirited defence of critical inquiry and evolutionary social ethics led him towards an entirely contradictory position In addition to profiles of individuals McKillop considers the ways in which their ideas operated in the context of Canadian institutions including the universities and the press From these perspectives emerges a detailed analysis of the life of the mind of English Canada in an age of questioning of doubt and of struggle to reorient the intellectual and philosophical positions of a quickly changing society Border Within Ian H. University College fire of 1890 the discovery of insulin involvement in the two world wars the student protests of the 1960s and the successful renewal of the 1980s and 1990s Friedland draws on archival records private diaries oral interviews and a vast body of secondary literature He draws also on his own experience of the University as a student in the 1950s and later as a faculty member and dean of law who played a part in some of the critical developments he unfolds The history of the University of Toronto as recounted by Friedland is intimately connected with events outside the University The transition in Canadian society for example from early dependence on Great Britain and fear of the United States to the present dominance of American culture and ideas is mirrored in the University There too can be seen the effects of the two world wars the cold war and the Vietnam war As Canadian society and culture have developed and changed so too has the University The history of the University in a sense is the history of Canada

Making a Middle Class Paul Axelrod,1990 Using a rich array of archival and quantitative sources and oral testimony from ex students across Canada Axelrod explores the characteristics and significance of university life during a trying decade He describes who went to university what they were taught how they amused themselves how they responded to the pressing political issues of the day and what became of them after graduation Axelrod argues that these students shared the aspirations of middle class communities elsewhere Dreading the prospect of downward social mobility they craved the status a university degree and professional credentials might produce Accordingly they forged an associational life on campus that challenged the control of paternalistic authorities perpetuated the values of middle class culture and helped them cope with the stresses of the time Women composed almost one quarter of the student population and faced discrimination inside and outside the classroom How they coped with this how they adapted their own expectations and how they contributed to campus and community culture are extensively discussed Through the prism of the student experience *Making a Middle Class* furnishes fresh insights into the social history of higher education the history of youth the history of the middle class and the history of the Depression Canadian Marxists and the Search for a Third Way Peter Campbell,2000-01-01

Focusing on four individuals *Canadian Marxists and the Search for a Third Way* describes the lives and ideas of Ernest Winch Bill Pritchard Bob Russell and Arthur Mould and examines their efforts to put their ideas into practice Campbell begins by looking at their childhoods in Great Britain particularly their religious upbringing He considers their family life their attitudes toward women and ethnic minorities what they were reading and what effect that reading had on their theory and practice He describes their lives as labor leaders and advocates of socialism revealing how tenaciously in an increasingly hierarchical bureaucratized and state driven capitalist society they held to the idea that socialism must be created by the working class itself This is a unique look at four Canadian Marxists and their struggle to create an educated disciplined democratic mass based movement for revolutionary change **Canada's Origins** Janet Ajzenstat,Peter J. Ajzenstat and Smith challenge the idea of Canada as a country whose liberal individualism unlike that of the United States is redeemed by a tradition of government intervention in economic and social life the so called tory touch This ground breaking book begins with the now classic article in which the red tory view was formulated It then presents a new and illuminating picture of Canadian political life in which liberal individualism confronts not toryism but the participatory tradition of civic republicanism In the final section the two editors one a liberal the other a civic republican debate the crucial questions dominating Canadian politics today including Quebec s search for recognition from the perspective of their shared understanding of Canada s founding **Remaking Liberalism** Barry Ferguson,1993-10-05 Adam Shortt began teaching

political economy at Queen s University in the late 1880s His theories attracted students and faculty who were interested in applying the new tenets of economics and political science to questions of Canadian public policy The concerns of the group

that formed around Shortt were broad and self consciously cumulative a perspective promoted particularly by Shortt's colleague and successor O D Skelton The group encouraged reassessment of the role of the social scientist in the university and society and analysed contentious economic and political questions of the day Addressing economic policies such as industrialization foreign investment labour business relations and prairie settlement they examined the political and governmental ramifications of economic problems concentrating on the role of political parties the broad role of government the place of the public service and ethnic class and regional political relations Ferguson demonstrates that Shortt Skelton Clark and Mackintosh clearly argued on behalf of the new liberalism emphasizing individual rights and positive government He suggests that their ideas reveal an intellectual position which differed from the imperialist and continentalist alternatives that dominated Canadian thinking at the time
