Frijda, 1993 Appraisal is a central notion in current theory A process of appraisal can be considered the key to understanding that emotions differ for different individuals Assuming a process of appraisal that mediates between events and emotions is the clue to understanding that a particular event evokes an emotion in one individual and not in another or evokes an emotion at one moment and no emotion or a weaker or stronger one at another moment A process of appraisal also explains why an emotionally charged event elicits this particular emotion and not another one in this particular individual under these particular conditions.
