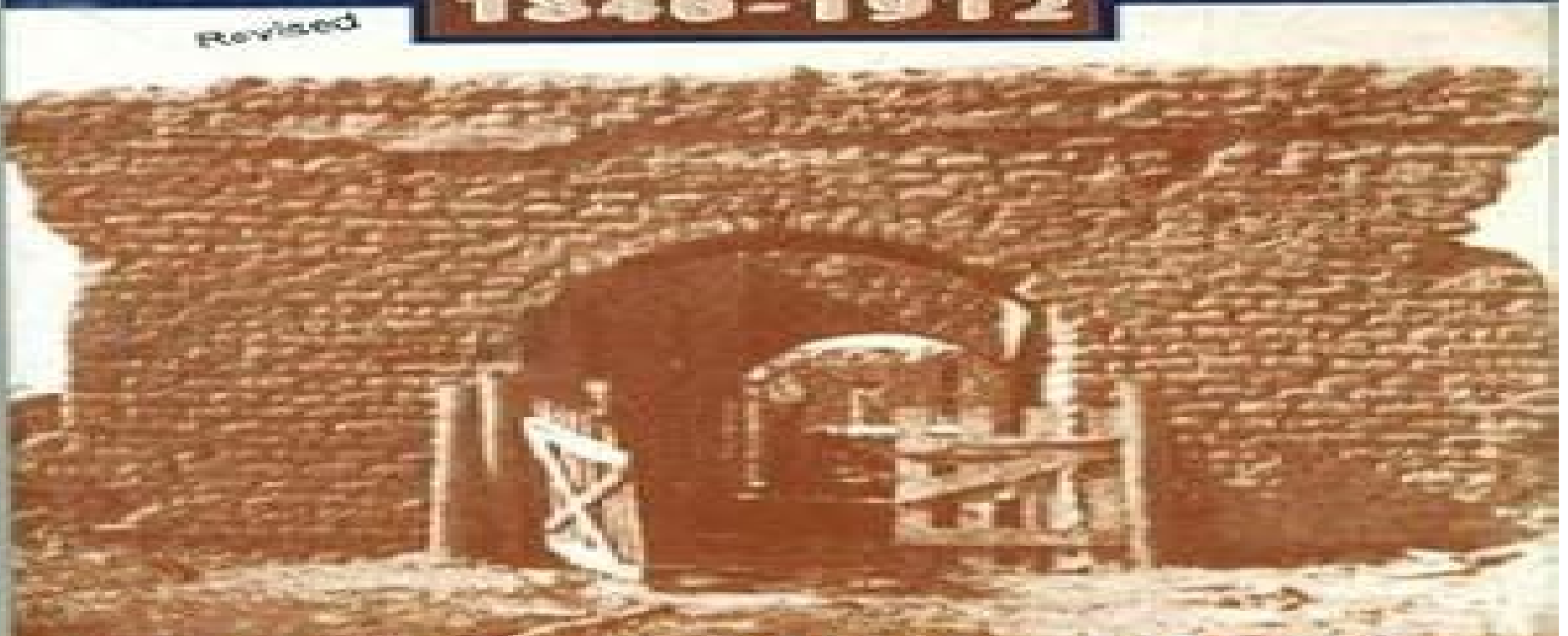

Frontier Cavalry Trooper Douglas C. McChristian, 2013-04-30 During his five years in the army Private Edward L Matthews wrote a series of exceptionally detailed and engaging letters to his family back home in Maryland describing his life in the Arizona and New Mexico Territories Eddie Matthews s letters published here for the first time provide an unparalleled chronicle of one soldier s experiences in garrison and in the field in the post Civil War Southwest Eddie s letters record a vivid chronicle of day to day life in the frontier regulars Included are operational details in his company candid observations of people and places intimate views of frontier society and personal opinions that probably would have been forgotten or moderated had he recorded his experiences later in life More subtle are his valuable references to the state of transportation and communication in the Southwest during the early 1870s Matthews probably did not realize until later years that he was not only a witness to the nation s rapid westward expansion but was himself a tiny cog in the machinery that made it possible

Alexander, 1998 **Frontier Forts and Outposts of New Mexico** Donna Blake Birchell, 2019 Life in early New Mexico was often perilous Geographic isolation attracted outlaws and ruffians and skirmishes often arose between the indigenous tribes and settlers In response the U S government set up military forts and outposts to protect its new citizens These strongholds include Fort Craig where logs were made to look like cannons to fool Confederate troops Kit Carson John Pershing and Billy the Kid all called Fort Stanton home before it became the first federal tuberculosis sanatorium and later a detention center for German prisoners of war Author Donna Blake Birchell relates little known yet highly important Civil War battles the tragedies of the Navajo and Mescalero Apache internments and other dramatic frontier stories

A Civil War History of the New Mexico Volunteers and Militia Jerry D. Thompson, 2015-09-01 The Civil War in New Mexico began in 1861 with the Confederate invasion and occupation of the Mesilla Valley At the same time small villages and towns in New Mexico Territory faced raids from Navajos and Apaches In response the commander of the Department of New Mexico Colonel Edward Canby and Governor Henry Connelly recruited what became the First and Second New Mexico Volunteer Infantry In this book leading Civil War historian Jerry Thompson tells their story for the first time along with the history of a third regiment of Mounted Infantry and several companies in a fourth regiment Thompson s focus is on the Confederate invasion of 1861 1862 and its effects especially the bloody Battle of Valverde The emphasis is on how the volunteer companies were raised who led them how they were organized armed and equipped what they endured off the battlefield how they adapted to military life and their interactions with New Mexico citizens and various hostile Indian groups including raiding by deserters and outlaws Thompson draws on service records and numerous other archival sources that few earlier scholars have seen His thorough accounting will be a gold mine for historians and genealogists especially the appendix which lists the names of all volunteers and militia men

Fort Bowie, Arizona Douglas C. McChristian, 2012-10-19 Fort Bowie in present day Arizona was established in 1862 at the

Lino, better known as Loco, was the only Apache leader to make a lasting peace with both Americans and Mexicans. Yet most historians have ignored his efforts and some Chiricahua descendants have branded him as fainthearted despite his well known valor in combat. In this engaging biography Bud Shapard tells the story of this important but overlooked chief against the backdrop of the harrowing Apache wars and eventual removal of the tribe from its homeland to prison camps in Florida, Alabama, and Oklahoma. Tracing the events of Loco's long tenure as a leader of the Warm Springs Chiricahua band, Shapard tells how Loco steered his followers along a treacherous path of unforeseeable circumstances and tragic developments in the mid to late 1800s. While recognizing the near impossibility of Apache-American coexistence, Loco persevered in his quest for peace against frustrating odds and often treacherous U.S. government policy. Even as Geronimo, Naiche, and others continued their raiding and sought to undermine Loco's efforts, this visionary chief, motivated by his love for children, maintained his commitment to keep Apache families safe from wartime dangers. Based on extensive research, including interviews with Loco's grandsons and other descendants, Shapard's biography is an important counterweight for historians and buffs interested in Apache history and a moving account of a leader ahead of his time.

Dragoons in Apacheland William S.

Kiser, 2014-12-04 In the fifteen years prior to the American Civil War, the U.S. Army established a presence in southern New Mexico, the homeland of Mescalero, Mimbres, and Mogollon bands of the Apache Indians. From the army's perspective, the Apaches presented an obstacle to be overcome in making the region newly acquired in the Mexican-American War safe for Anglo settlers. In *Dragoons in Apacheland*, William S. Kiser recounts the conflicts that ensued and examines how both Apache warriors and American troops shaped the future of the Southwest Borderlands. Kiser narrates two distinct contests: The Apaches were defending their territory against the encroachment of soldiers and settlers. At the same time, the Anglo-Americans maneuvered against one another in a competition for political and economic power and for Apache territory. Cross-cultural misunderstandings, political corruption in Santa Fe and Washington, anti-Indian racism, troublemakers among both Apaches and settlers, irresponsible army officers and troops, corrupt American and Mexican traders, and policy disagreements among government officials all contributed to the ongoing hostilities. Kiser examines the behaviors and motivations of individuals involved in all aspects of these local, regional, and national disputes. Kiser is one of only a few historians to deal with this crucial period in Indian-white relations in the Southwest and the first to detail the experiences of the First and Second United States Dragoon elite mounted troops, better equipped and trained than infantry, to confront Apache guerrilla warriors more accustomed to the southwestern environment. Often led by the Gila leader Mangas Coloradas, the Apaches fought desperately to protect their lands and way of life. The Americans, Kiser shows, used unauthorized tactics of total warfare, encouraging field units to attack villages and destroy crops and livestock, particularly when the Apaches refused to engage the troops in pitched battles. Kiser's insights into the pre-Civil War conflicts in southern New Mexico are essential to

a deeper understanding of the larger U S Apache war that culminated in the heroic resistance of Cochise Victorio and Geronimo

Masich, 2017-02-03 Still the least understood theater of the Civil War the Southwest Borderlands saw not only Union and Confederate forces clashing but Indians Hispanos and Anglos struggling for survival power and dominance on both sides of the U S Mexico border While other scholars have examined individual battles Andrew E Masich is the first to analyze these conflicts as interconnected civil wars Based on previously overlooked Indian Depredation Claim records and a wealth of other sources this book is both a close up history of the Civil War in the region and an examination of the war making traditions of its diverse peoples Along the border Masich argues the Civil War played out as a collision between three warrior cultures Indians Hispanos and Anglos brought their own weapons and tactics to the struggle but they also shared many traditions Before the war the three groups engaged one another in cycles of raid and reprisal involving the taking of livestock and human captives reflecting a peculiar mixture of conflict and interdependence When U S regular troops were withdrawn in 1861 to fight in the East the resulting power vacuum led to unprecedented violence in the West Indians fought Indians Hispanos battled Hispanos and Anglos vied for control of the Southwest while each group sought allies in conflicts related only indirectly to the secession crisis When Union and Confederate forces invaded the Southwest Anglo soldiers Hispanos and sedentary Indian tribes forged alliances that allowed them to collectively wage a relentless war on Apaches Comanches and Navajos Mexico s civil war and European intervention served only to enlarge the conflict in the borderlands When the fighting subsided a new power hierarchy had emerged and relations between the region s inhabitants and their nations forever changed Masich s perspective on borderlands history offers a single cohesive framework for understanding this power shift while demonstrating the importance of transnational and
