Meeks,2019-11-15 In *Border Citizens* historian Eric V Meeks explores how the racial classification and identities of the diverse indigenous mestizo and Euro American residents of Arizona s borderlands evolved as the region was politically and economically incorporated into the United States First published in 2007 the book examines the complex relationship between racial subordination and resistance over the course of a century On the one hand Meeks links the construction of multiple racial categories to the process of nation state building and capitalist integration On the other he explores how the region s diverse communities altered the blueprint drawn up by government officials and members of the Anglo majority for their assimilation or exclusion while redefining citizenship and national belonging The revised edition of this highly praised and influential study features a chapter length afterword that details and contextualizes Arizona s aggressive response to undocumented immigration and ethnic studies in the decade after *Border Citizens* was first published Meeks demonstrates that the broad based movement against these measures had ramifications well beyond Arizona He also revisits the Yaqui and Tohono O odham nations on both sides of the Sonora Arizona border focusing on their efforts to retain extend and enrich their connections to one another in the face of increasingly stringent border enforcement **100 Western Women** Jan Cleere,2025-03-12 History books record scant contributions women made in settling and developing the new territory of Arizona Yet women were an integral part of civilizing the rough rowdy often dangerous land For more than ten years Jan Cleere has written about the women who influenced the growth and development of Arizona in her column *Western Women* that appears monthly in the *Arizona Daily Star* newspaper The famous infamous and those not so well known are featured each with a compelling story of surviving and thriving under less than ideal circumstances Warriors basket weavers ranchers artists innkeepers schoolteachers politicians and entrepreneurs from a remarkable variety of backgrounds and cultures influenced the growth of Arizona Read about Larcena Pennington who had to crawl down a mountain to escape her Indian captors Hopi artist Nampeyo continued to make exquisite pots even after she started losing her eyesight Carmen Vasquez built a theater and brought in shows from as far away as Spain Elizabeth Hudson Smith ran a successful hotel until the color of her skin turned a town against her And Sarah Gorby allowed injured animals to live in her home until they could return to

their desert habitats The 100 Western women featured between these pages are just a handful of those who came before and after them as the territory emerged and flourished into an amazing and diverse state unlike any other in the nation

Rehnquist Herman Obermayer, 2009-09-15 In *Rehnquist* former editor and publisher Herman Obermayer completes the historical portrait of Supreme Court Justice William H Rehnquist through personal observations and recollections a memoir of friendship and a final act of posthumous loyalty The impact of Chief Justice William Rehnquist who served as a Supreme Court justice for a third of a century and headed the federal judiciary under four presidents cannot be overstated His dissenting opinion in *Roe v Wade* and his strongly stated positions on issues as various as freedom of the press school prayer and civil rights would guarantee his memory on their own Chiefly though William Rehnquist will always be remembered for his highly visible role in two of the most important and contentious political events of recent American history the impeachment trial of President Bill Clinton in 1999 and the Supreme Court's decision that made George W Bush the victor in the presidential election of 2000 Despite his importance as a public figure however William Rehnquist scrupulously preserved his private life And while his judicial opinions often inflamed passions and aroused both ire and praise they were rarely personal The underlying quirks foibles and eccentricities of the man were always under wraps Now however journalist Herman J Obermayer has broken that silence in a memoir of their nineteen year friendship that is both factually detailed and intensely moving his own personal tribute to his dearest friend In these pages we meet for the first time William Rehnquist the man in a portrait that can only serve to enhance the legacy of a Chief Justice who will be remembered in history as being among America's most influential

John J. Rhodes J. Brian Smith, 2005 The life of John Jacob Rhodes is in part the story of a man thrust from the relative obscurity of the House to the forefront of what became America's most serious constitutional crisis since the Civil War the drive to impeach President Richard M Nixon As House Republican Leader John Rhodes was compelled

The Hello Girls Elizabeth Cobbs Hoffman, Elizabeth Cobbs, 2017-04-06 This is the story of how America s first women soldiers helped win World War I earned the vote and fought the U S Army In 1918 the U S Army Signal Corps sent 223 women to France They were masters of the latest technology the telephone switchboard General John Pershing commander of the American Expeditionary Forces demanded female wire experts when he discovered that inexperienced doughboys were unable to keep him connected with troops under fire Without communications for even an hour the army would collapse While suffragettes picketed the White House and President Woodrow Wilson struggled to persuade a segregationist Congress to give women of all races the vote these competent and courageous young women swore the Army oath Elizabeth Cobbs reveals the challenges they faced in a war zone where male soldiers welcomed resented wooed mocked saluted and ultimately celebrated them They received a baptism by fire when German troops pounded Paris with heavy artillery Some followed Black Jack Pershing to battlefields where they served through shelling and bombardment Grace Banker their 25 year old leader won the Distinguished Service Medal The army discharged the last Hello Girls in 1920 the same year Congress ratified the Nineteenth Amendment granting the ballot When the operators sailed home the army unexpectedly dismissed them without veterans benefits They began a sixty year battle that a handful of survivors carried to triumph in 1979 With the help of the National Organization for Women Senator Barry Goldwater and a crusading Seattle attorney they triumphed over the U S Army

Ernest W. McFarland James Elton McMillan, 2004 As a U S senator Ernest McFarland sponsored more than forty congressional laws including the landmark GI Bill in 1944 Twice

he led the Central Arizona Project CAP to passage in the Senate on its way to ultimate success and his dedication led to his selection as U S Senate majority leader After losing to Barry Goldwater in 1952 McFarland returned to Arizona led a Democratic resurgence and became a two term governor He enjoyed notable achievements preparing the way for industrial expansion in the state and successfully arguing the CAP case before the U S Supreme Court At age seventy he successfully ran for the Arizona Supreme Court where he wrote the controversial decision that was overturned by the U S Supreme Court in Miranda v Arizona He rose to chief justice in 1968 thus achieving the unique political triple crown of serving in the highest position in the legislative executive and judicial branches of state government Mac passed away in Phoenix in 1984 at age 89 having risen from a log cabin in Oklahoma to Capitol Hill and to the Arizona statehouse working alongside such notables as Harry Truman and Lyndon Johnson in a career marked by selfless concern for the common person and stewardship of his nation

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
