Davis, 2003 *Russia Engages the World 1453 1825* an elegant new book created by a team of leading historians in collaboration with The New York Public Library traces Russia's development from an insular medieval liturgical realm centered on Old Muscovy into a modern secular world power embodied in cosmopolitan St Petersburg. Featuring eight essays and 120 images from the Library's distinguished collections it is both an engagingly written work and a striking visual object. Anyone interested in the dramatic history of Russia and its extraordinary artifacts will be captivated by this book. Before the late fifteenth century Europeans knew virtually nothing about Muscovy the core of what would become the Russian Empire. The rare visitor merchant adventurer diplomat described an exotic alien place. Then under the powerful tsar Peter the Great St Petersburg became the architectural embodiment and principal site of a cultural revolution and the port of entry for the Europeanization of Russia. From the reign of Peter to that of Catherine the Great Russia sought increasing involvement in the scientific advancements and cultural trends of Europe. Yet Russia harbored a certain dualism when engaging the world outside its borders identifying at times with Europe and at other times with its Asian neighbors. The essays are enhanced by images of rare Russian books illuminated manuscripts maps engravings watercolors and woodcuts from the fifteenth to the nineteenth centuries as well as the treasures of diverse minority cultures living in the territories of the Empire or acquired by Russian voyagers. These materials were also featured in an exhibition of the same name mounted at The New York Public Library in the fall of 2003 to celebrate the tercentenary of St Petersburg.

A final chapter evaluates Siberia's role in the twentieth century. This book will be of interest to students and researchers of history. *Where the Waves Fall* K.R. Howe, 2023-05-03 *Where the Waves Fall* 1984 centres the stories of the Pacific Islanders and how they were affected by European explorers and colonisers in this unique account of

human settlement and cultural interchange in the Pacific islands It follows the fortunes of the seafarers who discovered island after island in the world s largest ocean traces the development of their civilisations and examines in depth the interaction between them and the newcomers European explorers traders beachcombers missionaries merchants who from the sixteenth century came in an increasing series of waves The book s framework enables the author to throw new light on hitherto isolated events Novel suggestions are advanced as to why some islands became kingdoms in the earlier years of European contact and why others did not and of how and why missionaries were accepted on some islands but not on others Nor does Professor Howe shrink from provocative and at times controversial arguments concerning the ambitions and strategies of island leaders and indeed the overall nature and extent of the initiatives taken by the islanders

Ranzan, 2019-07-16 A personal account of Commodore Perry s landmark expedition to Japan and life in the antebellum navy George B Gideon Jr served as second assistant engineer aboard the USS Powhatan from 1852 to 1856 From his position on the steam frigate Gideon traveled to Singapore Labuan Borneo Hong Kong and many other Asian lands During his time at sea Gideon penned dozens of letters to his wife Lide back home in Philadelphia Recently discovered in the attic of his great great grandniece were fifty one letters penned by Gideon providing thorough and insightful commentary throughout the voyage Through these correspondences Gideon laboriously documents the details of his daily life on board from the food they ate to the technical aspects of his work as well as observations concerning the historical events unfolding around him such as Chinese piracy the Taiping Rebellion the Crimean War and the devastation of Shimoda *To My Dearest Wife Lide Letters from George B Gideon Jr during Commodore Perry s Expedition to Japan 1853 1855* is a rare first person account of the landmark American naval expedition to Japan to establish commercial relations between the two countries Gideon s letters have been meticulously transcribed and annotated by the editors and are an invaluable primary historical source Gideon s letters are candid and revealing delving into the rampant dysfunction in the navy of the 1850s sickness and disease alcohol abuse and poor leadership among other challenges Gideon also unabashedly shares his own cynical views of the navy s role in supporting American economic interests in Japan This firsthand account of the political mission of the Perry expedition is a unique contribution to naval and military history and gives readers a better view of life aboard a navy ship

military importance which was underscored during the Cold War The developing military garrison brought federal money and many new residents Then the discovery of huge oil and natural gas deposits gave a measure of economic security to the state Alaska A History provides a full chronological survey of the region s and state s history including the precedent setting Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act of 1971 which compensated Native Americans for their losses the effect of the oil industry and the trans Alaska pipeline on the economy the Exxon Valdez oil spill and Alaska politics through the early 2000s

Russian Colonization of Alaska, 2020-11 In *Russian Colonization of Alaska Baranov s Era 1799 1818* Andrei Val terovich Grin v examines the sociohistorical origins of the former Russian colonies in Alaska or Russian America The formation of the Russian American Company and the concentration in the hands of Aleksandr Baranov of all the power in south and southeast Alaska s Russian settlements marked a new stage in the history of Russian America Expanding and strengthening Russian possessions in the New World as much as possible Baranov acted in favor of his country before himself in accordance with the principle people for the empire and not the empire for the people *Russian Colonization of Alaska* is the first comprehensive study to analyze the origin and evolution of Russian colonization based on research into political economy history and ethnography Grin v s study elaborates the social political spiritual ideological personal and psychological aspects of Russian America accounting for the idiosyncrasies of the natural environment competition from other North American empires and challenges from Alaska Natives and individual colonial diplomats Rather than being simply a continuation of Russians colonization of Siberia the colonization of Alaska was instead part of overarching Russian and global history

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
