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Applied Grammatology Gregory L. Ulmer, 1985 Originally published in 1984 In *Applied Grammatology* Gregory Ulmer provides an extraordinary introduction to the third applied phase of grammatology the science of writing outlined by Jacques Derrida in *Of Grammatology* Ulmer looks to the later experimental works of Derrida beginning with *Glas* and continuing through *Truth in Painting* and *The Post Card* In these he discovers a critical methodology radically different from the deconstruction for which Derrida is known At the same time he finds the source of a new pedagogy for all the humanities one based on grammatology and appropriate to the era of audiovisual communications in which we live Detractors of Derrida often accuse him of superficial wordplay and of using images and puns as nonfunctional subversions of academic conventions Ulmer argues that there is in fact a fully developed use of homonyms in Derrida's style which produces its own distinctive knowledge and insight Derrida's experiments with images moreover his expansion of descriptions of everyday objects such as umbrellas matchboxes and post cards into cognitive models serve to reveal a simplicity underlying intellectual discourse which could be used to eliminate the gap separating the general public from specialists in cultural studies Comparing the stylistic innovations of Derrida with Jacques Lacan's use of puns and diagrams with the German performance artist Joseph Beuys's demonstration of models and with the montage writing of the films of Sergei Eisenstein Ulmer explores the possibility of deriving a postmodernist pedagogy from Derrida's texts The first study to suggest the full potential of the program available in Derrida's writings *Applied Grammatology* is also the first outline of a Derridean alternative to deconstructionism With its shift away from Derrida's philosophical studies to his experimental texts Ulmer's book aims to inaugurate a new movement in the American adaptation of contemporary French theory

Pedagogical Encounters in the Post-Anthropocene, Volume 2 Jan Jagodzinski,2024-04-26 As a follow up to Pedagogical Encounters in the Post Anthropocene Volume I this book addresses three major areas in response to the post Anthropocene Technology Neurology Quantum Each of these areas is broadly addressed in relation to the concerns that have arisen both theoretically and educationally As in Volume I the author terms these to be encounters as each area presents a particular problematic when addressing the phase change that the planet is undergoing where the anthropogenic labour of global humanity is contributing to climate change endangering our very existence Technology in education has been a significant development There is a concerted effort to review this development placing stress on the rise of learning machines and algorithms In the second encounter the vast literature on neurology is addressed especially neurodiversity and the various symptoms that have emerged in the post Anthropocene era The last section reviews issues related to quantum theory as this is fundamental to tensions between physics and metaphysics The volume concludes with the author s own pedagogical proposal for the future

Seduction, Sophistry, and the Woman with the Rhetorical Figure Michelle Ballif, 2001. Ballif questions why the profession wants to retain these beliefs in the face of vociferous arguments from new rhetorics that the discipline no longer posits a foundational self or truth and in the face of the poststructuralist critique which has demonstrated that founding truth is always accomplished by first positing and then negating an other. As an alternative to this negative and violent rhetorical process, Ballif suggests a turn to sophistry as embodied in the figure of Woman, one with the power to seduce us literally to lead astray from our truth and our demand for it.

The Pedagogical Contract Yun Lee Too, 2000-07-13. *The Pedagogical Contract* explores the relationship between teacher and student and argues for ways of reconceiving pedagogy. It discloses this relationship as one that since antiquity has been regarded as a scene of give and take where the teacher exchanges knowledge for some sort of payment by the student and where pedagogy always runs the risk of becoming a broken contract. The book seeks to liberate teaching and learning from this historical scene and the anxieties that it engenders, arguing that there are alternative ways of conceiving the economy underlying pedagogical activities. Reading ancient material together with contemporary representations of teaching and learning, Yun Lee Too shows that apart from being conceived as a scene of self-interest in which a professional teacher or sophist is the charlatan who cheats his pupil, pedagogy might also purport to be a disinterested process of socialization or a scene in which lack and neediness are redeemed through the realization that they are required precisely to stimulate the desire to learn. The author also argues that pedagogy ideally ignores the imperative of the conventional marketplace for relevance, utility, and productivity inasmuch as teaching and learning most enrich a community when they disregard the immediate material concerns of the community. The book will appeal to all those who understand scholarship as having an important social and/or political role to play; it will also be of interest to literary scholars, literary and cultural theorists, philosophers, historians, legal theorists, feminists, scholars of education, sociologists, and political theorists. Yun Lee Too is Assistant Professor of Classics, Columbia University. She is the author of *Rethinking Sexual Harassment: The Rhetoric of Identity in Socrates' Text*, *Power Pedagogy*, and *The Idea of Ancient Literary Criticism* (forthcoming) and coeditor with Niall Livingstone of *Pedagogy and Power: Rhetorics of Classical Learning*.

Quantum Anthropologies Vicki Kirby, 2013-07-22. In *Quantum Anthropologies*, the renowned feminist theorist Vicki Kirby contends that some of the most provocative aspects of deconstruction have yet to be explored. Deconstruction's implications have been curtailed by the

assumption that issues of textuality and representation are specific to the domain of culture Revisiting Derrida's claim that there is no outside of text Kirby argues that theories of cultural construction developed since the linguistic turn have inadvertently reproduced the very binaries they intended to question such as those between nature and culture matter and ideation and fact and value Through new readings of Derrida Husserl Saussure Butler Irigaray and Merleau Ponty Kirby exposes the limitations of theories that regard culture as a second order system that cannot access much less be nature body and materiality She suggests ways of reconceiving language and culture to enable a more materially implicated outcome one that keeps alive the more counterintuitive and challenging aspects of poststructural criticism By demonstrating how fields including cybernetics biology forensics mathematics and physics can be conceptualized in deconstructive terms Kirby fundamentally rethinks deconstruction and its relevance to nature embodiment materialism and science
