The Appropriated Voice Bette Lynn London,1990 Uses feminist theory cultural criticism cultural ethnography and narrative theory in critiquing traditional and revisionist criticism **Conrad, Language, and Narrative** Michael Greaney,2001-11-15 In this re evaluation of the writings of Joseph Conrad Michael Greaney places language and narrative at the heart of his literary achievement A trilingual Polish expatriate Conrad brought a formidable linguistic self consciousness to the English novel tensions between speech and writing are the defining obsessions of his career He sought very early on to develop a writing of the voice based on oral or communal modes of storytelling Greaney argues that the yarns of his nautical raconteur Marlow are the most challenging expression of this voice centred aesthetic But Conrad s suspicion that words are fundamentally untrustworthy is present in everything he wrote The political novels of his middle period represent a breakthrough from traditional storytelling into the writerly aesthetic of high modernism Greaney offers an examination of a wide range of Conrad s work which combines recent critical approaches to language in post structuralism with an impressive command of linguistic theory The Cambridge Companion to E. Craft-Fairchild,2012-03-31 Terry Castle s recent study of masquerade follows Bakhtin s analysis of the carnivalesque to conclude that for women masquerade offered exciting possibilities for social and sexual freedom Castle s interpretation conforms to the fears expressed by male writers during the period Addison Steele and Fielding all insisted that masquerade allowed women to usurp the privileges of men Female authors however often mistrusted these claims perceiving that masquerade s apparent freedoms were frequently nothing more than sophisticated forms of oppression Catherine Craft Fairchild s work provides a useful corrective to Castle s treatment of masquerade She argues that in fictions by Aphra Behn Mary Davys Eliza Haywood Elizabeth Inchbald and Frances Burney masquerade is double sided It is represented in some cases as a disempowering capitulation to patriarchal strictures that posit female subordination Often within the same text however masquerade is also depicted as an empowering defiance of the dominant norms for female behavior Heroines who attempt to separate themselves from the image of womanhood they consciously construct escape victimization In both cases masquerade is the condition of femininity gender in the woman s novel is constructed rather than essential Craft Fairchild examines the guises in which womanhood appears analyzing the ways in which women writers both construct and deconstruct eighteenth century cultural conceptions of femininity She offers a careful and engaging textual analysis of both canonical and noncanonical eighteenth century texts thereby setting lesser read fictions into a critical dialogue with more widely known novels Detailed readings are informed throughout by the ideas of current feminist theorists including Luce Irigaray Julia Kristeva Mary Ann Doane and Kaja Silverman Instead of assuming that fictions about women were based on biological fact Craft Fairchild stresses the opposite the domestic novel itself constructs the domestic woman **Popular Modernity in America** Michael Thomas

Hellenism and Loss in the Work of Virginia Woolf Theodore Koulouris, 2016-04-22 Taking up Virginia Woolf s fascination with Greek literature and culture this book explores her engagement with the nineteenth century phenomenon of British Hellenism and her transformation of that multifaceted socio cultural and political reality into a particular textual aesthetic which Theodore Koulouris defines as Greekness Woolf was a lifelong student of Greek but from 1907 to 1909 she kept notes on her Greek readings in the Greek Notebook an obscure and largely unexamined manuscript that contains her analyses of a number of canonical Greek texts including Plato s Symposium Homer s Odyssey and Euripides Ion Koulouris s examination of this

manuscript uncovers crucial insights into the early development of Woolf's narrative styles and helps establish the link between Greekness and loss Woolf's Greekness Koulouris argues enabled her to navigate male and female appropriations of British Hellenism and provided her with a means of articulating loss whether it be loss of a great Hellenic past women's vocalities immediate family members or human civilization during the formative decades of the twentieth century In drawing attention to the centrality of Woolf's early Greek studies for the elegiac quality of her writing Koulouris maps a new theoretical terrain that involves reassessing long established views on Woolf and the Greeks
