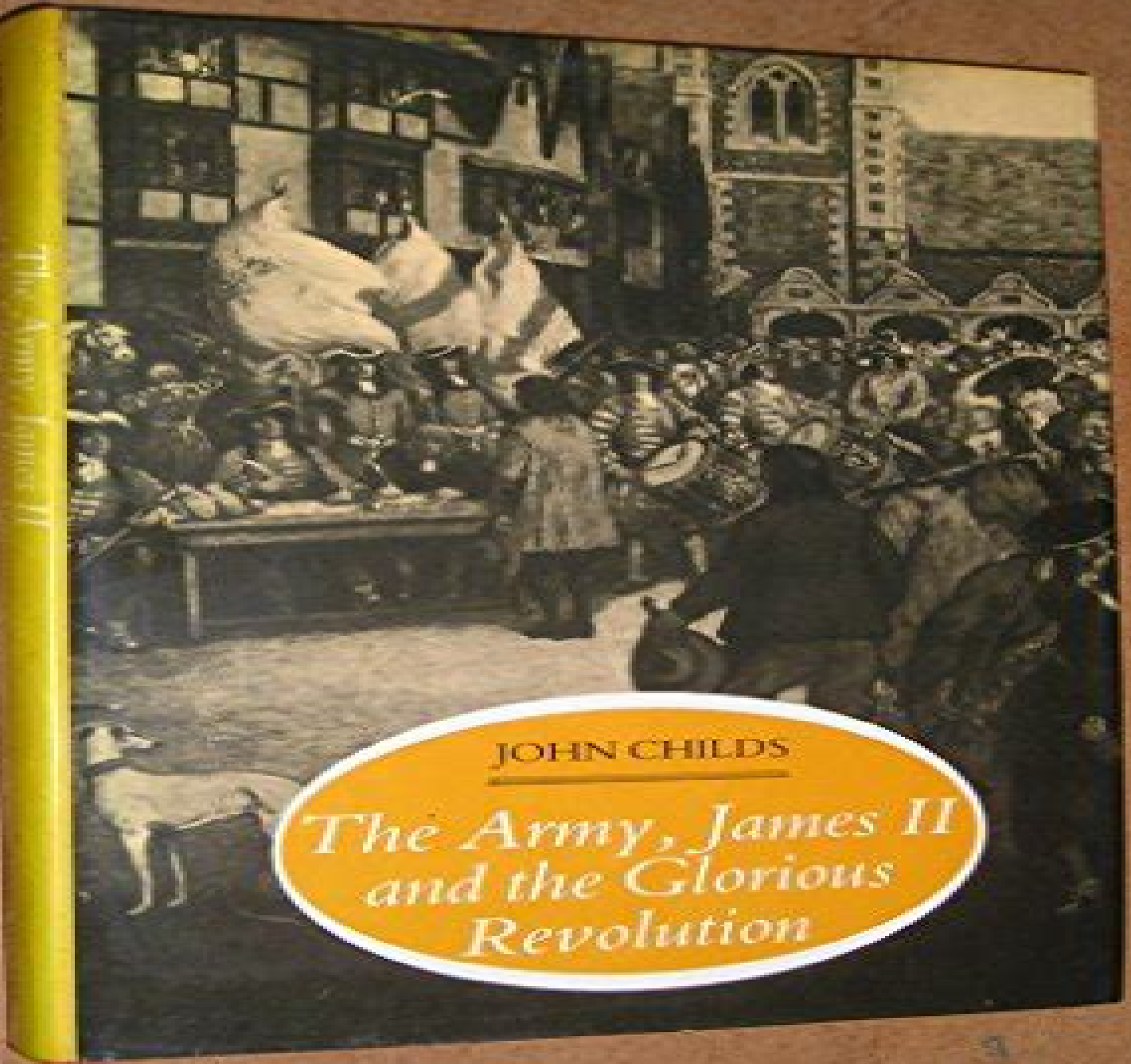

Speck,2016-04-15 Forced out of power in theGlorious Revolution of 1688 and defeated in the subsequent battle of the Boyne by William of Orange the short reign of James II has an importance that reaches far beyond his three years in power An ardent Roman Catholic his efforts to return England to the Catholic faith resonate to this day in Northern Ireland Similarly his attacks on the representative institutions that had been developing since the Restoration alienated an initially enthusiastic parliament William Speck looks at all these issues through the figure of the King Far more broad ranging than other histories of James II the book examines James role in the American colonies assigned to him by his brother Charles II his role in Scotland between 1679 and 1862 and his final exercise of power in Ireland *European Military Books and Intellectual Cultures of War in 17th-Century Russia* Oleg Rusakovskiy,2024-09-16 This book discusses the role Western military books and their translations played in 17th century Russia By tracing how these translations were produced distributed and read the study argues that foreign military treatises significantly shaped intellectual culture of the Russian elite It also presents Tsar Peter the Great in a new light not only as a military and political leader but as a devoted book reader and passionate student of military science *James II* John Miller,2008-10-01 James II 1633 1701 lacked the charisma of his father Charles I but shared his tendency to dismiss the views of others when they differed from his own Failing to understand his subjects James was also misunderstood by them In this highly regarded biography John Miller reassesses James II and his reign drawing on a wide array of primary sources from France Italy and Ireland as well as England Miller argues that the king had many laudable attributes he was brave loyal honorable and hard working and he was at least as benevolent toward his people as his father had been Yet James s conversion to Catholicism fueled the distrust of his Protestant subjects who placed the worst possible construction on his actions and statements Although James came to see the securing of religious freedom for Catholics in the wider context of freedom for all religious minorities his people naturally doubted the sincerity of his commitment to toleration The book explores James s relations with the state and society focusing on the political diplomatic and religious issues that shaped his reign Miller discusses the human failings the gulf of understanding between the king and his subjects and the sheer bad luck that led to James s downfall He also considers the reasons for James s lack of interest in recovering his kingdom after his flight to France in 1688 This revised edition of the book includes a substantial new foreword assessing recent work on the reign This is a first class essay in historical biography It must displace all previous lives of James II J P Kenyon Observer **James II: King in Exile** John Callow,2011-11-30

Hospital Care and the British Standing Army, 1660-1714 Eric Gruber von Arni, 2017-09-29. At the Restoration of the Monarchy in 1660, amongst the first acts of Charles II's government was the abolition of the New Model Army and the sweeping away of the legislation and institutions that had supported it, including most of the medical provisions provided by the republican regime. Nevertheless, a small rump of the Commonwealth forces was retained to form a royal standing army, which rapidly expanded over the next sixty years to become a formidable fighting force. Inevitably, as this force grew, the new government was compelled to provide medical care for its soldiers and ex-servicemen. Taking a broadly chronological approach, this book explores the nature and the quality of medical nursing and welfare facilities provided in hospitals for soldiers during the formative years of the British standing army between 1660 and 1714. It shows how, over the course of the latter part of the seventeenth century, the British army adapted and developed its facilities in line with new advances in science, medicine and

military theory Increased involvement in continental wars and contact with European armies provided inspiration for the founding of the well known Royal Hospitals at Chelsea and Kilmainham based on Louis XIV's H tel des Invalides The work also provides an in depth examination of the work of the hitherto sparsely documented field hospitals that provided acute casualty care to troops during the reigns of James II William III and Queen Anne Following on from his ground breaking study of medical care during the English Civil Wars Justice to the Maimed Soldier Eric Gruber von Arni in this study shows how the British army of the Restoration period struggled to develop systems and institutions that could cope with the increasing scale of contemporary warfare Through extensive archival research and a thorough understanding of military medical requirements a lucid account is provided that will be of interest not only to military and medical historians but also anyone interested in the development of early modern institutions and organisations *Deposing Monarchs* Cathleen Sarti,2021-12-30 *Deposing Monarchs* analyses depositions in Northern Europe between 1500 and 1700 as a type of frequent political conflict which allows to present new ideas on early modern state formation monarchy and the conventions of royal rulership The book revises earlier conceptualizations of depositions as isolated unique events that emerged in the context of national historiographies An examination of the official legitimations of depositions reveals that in times of crisis concepts of tradition rule of law and political consensus are much more influential than the divine right of kings Tracing the similarities and differences of depositions in Northern Europe transnationally and diachronically the book shows monarchical succession as more non linear than previously presumed It offers a transferable model of the different elements needed in depositions such as opposition to the monarch by multiple groups in a realm the need for a convincing rival candidate and a legitimation based on political traditions or religious ideas Furthermore the book bolsters our understanding of authority and rule as a constant process of negotiation adding to recent research on political culture and on the cultural history of politics

Redefining William III David Onnekink, Esther Mijers, 2016-04-08 William III 1650 1702 was Stadholder in the United Provinces and King of England Scotland and Ireland His reign has always intrigued historians as it encompassed such defining events as the Dutch year of Disaster 1672 the Glorious Revolution 1688 and the ensuing wars against France Although William has played a pivotal role in the political and religious history of his countries the significance and international impact of his reign is still not very well understood This volume contains a number of innovative essays from specialists in the field which have evolved from papers delivered to an international conference held at the University of Utrecht in December 2002 By focusing on the entire period 1650 1702 from an international perspective the volume moves historical discussion away from the traditional analysis of single events to encompass William's entire reign from a variety of political religious intellectual and cultural positions In so doing it offers a new perspective on the British and Dutch reigns of William III as well as the wider European milieu **The Right to Bear Arms** Stephen P.
