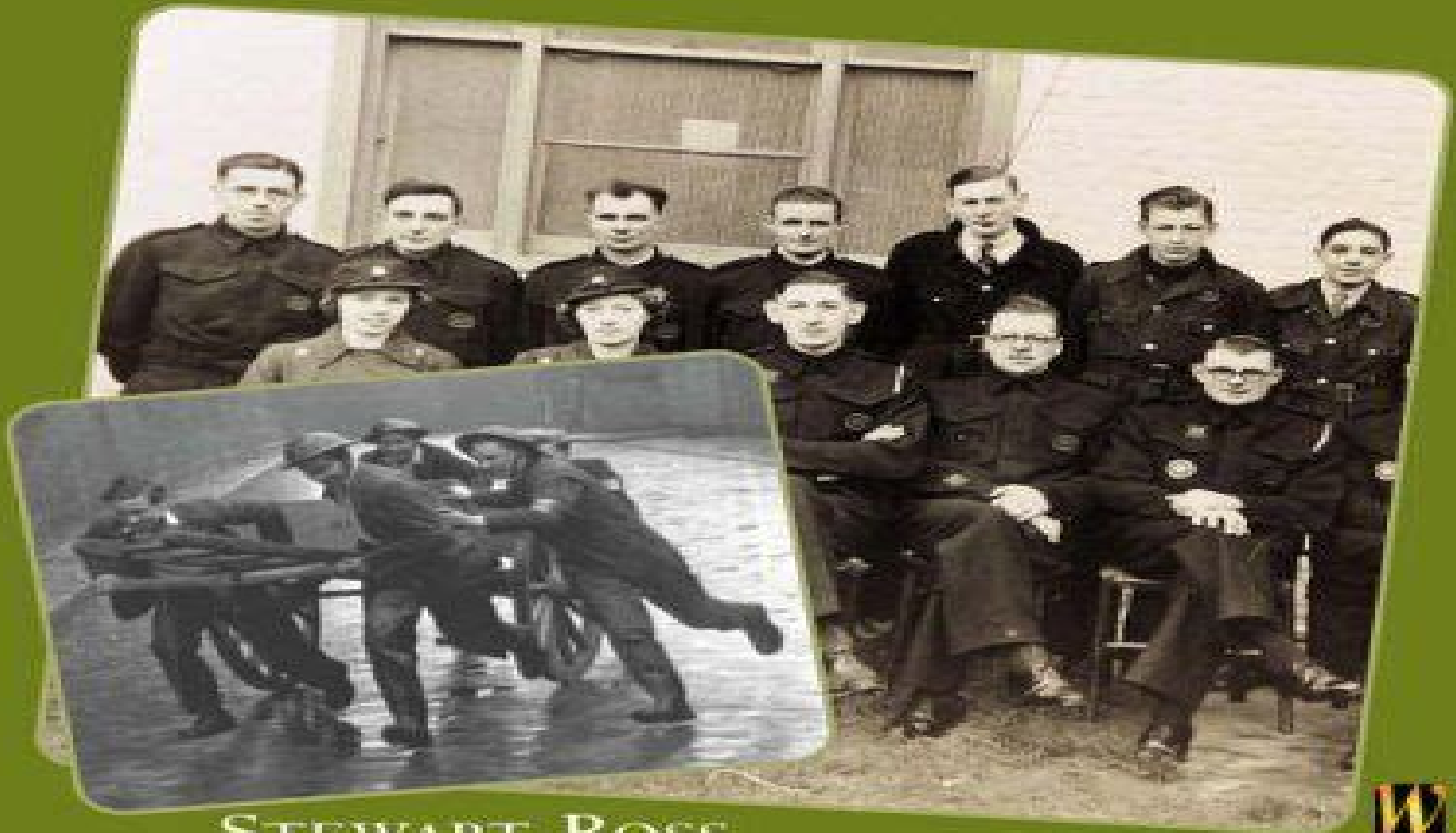

Internal Revenue Service,1993 **My War Story** Joshua Lowcock,2020-04-25 At age 21 William Bill Mackenzie Lowcock enlisted in the AIF and found himself in Singapore A few months later just shy of his 22nd birthday he found himself a Prisoner of War What followed for Bill was three years of forced POW labour on the infamous Thai Burma Railway the Death Railway This is his story from the Back Cover Sixteen year old William Bill Mackenzie Lowcock enlisted in the militia and at the breakout of World War II served on guard duty on various key infrastructures in Sydney and its surrounds Keen to serve Australia at age twenty one Bill joined the AIF and soon found himself in Singapore serving as a Private in the 2 19 Infantry Battalion Administrative HQ Known to his comrades as Lofty thanks to his 6'2" height Bill's experiences in Singapore and Malaysia tell in a matter of fact way the realities of day to day military life This all changed when in 1941 Japan entered the war Just a few months later in 1942 just shy of Bill's twenty second birthday he found himself a Prisoner of War when Singapore surrendered to the Japanese What followed for Bill was three years of forced POW labour on the infamous Thai Burma Railway Known as the Death Railway of the 13 000 Australians forced to work there almost 3 000 perished Despite many close calls Bill emerged as one of the lucky ones Bill's story charts his experiences throughout this period retold in Bill's characteristically understated humble tones a candid story of survival but told with humour and free of pessimism or woe despite obviously horrendous conditions This book is dedicated to the memory of Private Bill Lowcock and to all those who have served **Which People's War?** Sonya O. Rose,2003 Which People's War examines how national belonging or British national identity was envisaged in the public culture of the World War II home front Using materials from newspapers magazines films novels diaries letters and all sorts of public documents it explores such questions as who was included as British and what did it mean to be British How did the British describe themselves as a singular people and what were the consequences of those depictions It also examines the several meanings

of citizenship elaborated in various discussions concerning the British nation at war This investigation of the powerful constructions of national identity and understandings of citizenship circulating in Britain during the Second World War exposes their multiple and contradictory consequences at the time It reveals the fragility of any singular conception of Britishness even during a war that involved the total mobilization of the country's citizenry and cost 400 000 British civilian lives

Changing Women's Lives Alison Wilson, 2014-06-11 Rosemary Murray 1913-2004 was the eldest of six children in a happy talented and energetic family whose deeply engrained attitude of service to the community she inherited She studied chemistry at Oxford becoming one of the first women at LMH to achieve a DPhil in science and began an academic career as a lecturer at Royal Holloway College The charmed world of Rosemary's childhood and student days vanished abruptly with the outbreak of war Enlisting in the WRNS as a rating she served from 1942-46 attaining the rank of Chief Officer Post war she was head hunted by Cambridge University as Demonstrator in Chemistry combined with a Lectureship at Girton College Here she became interested in women's education witnessing the success of the long battle to allow women to take degrees and becoming a committee member of the Third Foundation Association a movement to set up a third women's college Eventually when New Hall was started she became its first Tutor in Charge and later President She went on to become the first woman Vice Chancellor of Cambridge University

Blood, Sweat, and Toil Geoffrey G. Field, 2011-11-03 Blood Sweat and Toil is the first scholarly history of the British working class in the Second World War It integrates social political and labour history and reflects the most recent scholarship and debates on social class gender and the forging of identities Geoffrey G Field examines the war's impact on workers in the varied contexts of the family military service the workplace local communities and the nation Previous studies of the Home Front have analysed the lives of civilians but they have neglected the importance of social class in defining popular experience and its centrality in public attitudes official policy and the politics of the war years Contrary to accounts that view the war as eroding class divisions and creating a new sense of social unity in Britain Field argues that the 1940s was a crucial decade in which the deeply fragmented working class of the interwar decades was remade achieving

new collective status power and solidarity He criticizes recent revisionist scholarship that has downplayed the significance of class in British society Extensively researched using official documents diaries and letters the records of trade unions and numerous other institutions Blood Sweat and Toil traces the rapid growth of trade unionism joint consultation and strike actions in the war years It also analyses the mobilization of women into factories and the uniformed services and the lives of men conscripted into the army showing how these experiences shaped their social attitudes and aspirations Using opinion polls and other evidence Field traces the evolution of popular political attitudes from the evacuation of 1939 and the desperate months of late 1940 to the election of 1945 opposing recent claims that the electorate was indifferent or apathetic at the war s end but also eschewing blanket assumptions about popular radicalization Labour was an active agent in fashioning itself as both a national progressive party and the representative of working class interests in 1945 far from a mere passive beneficiary of anti Tory feeling it gave organizational form to the idealism and the demand for significant change that the war had generated
