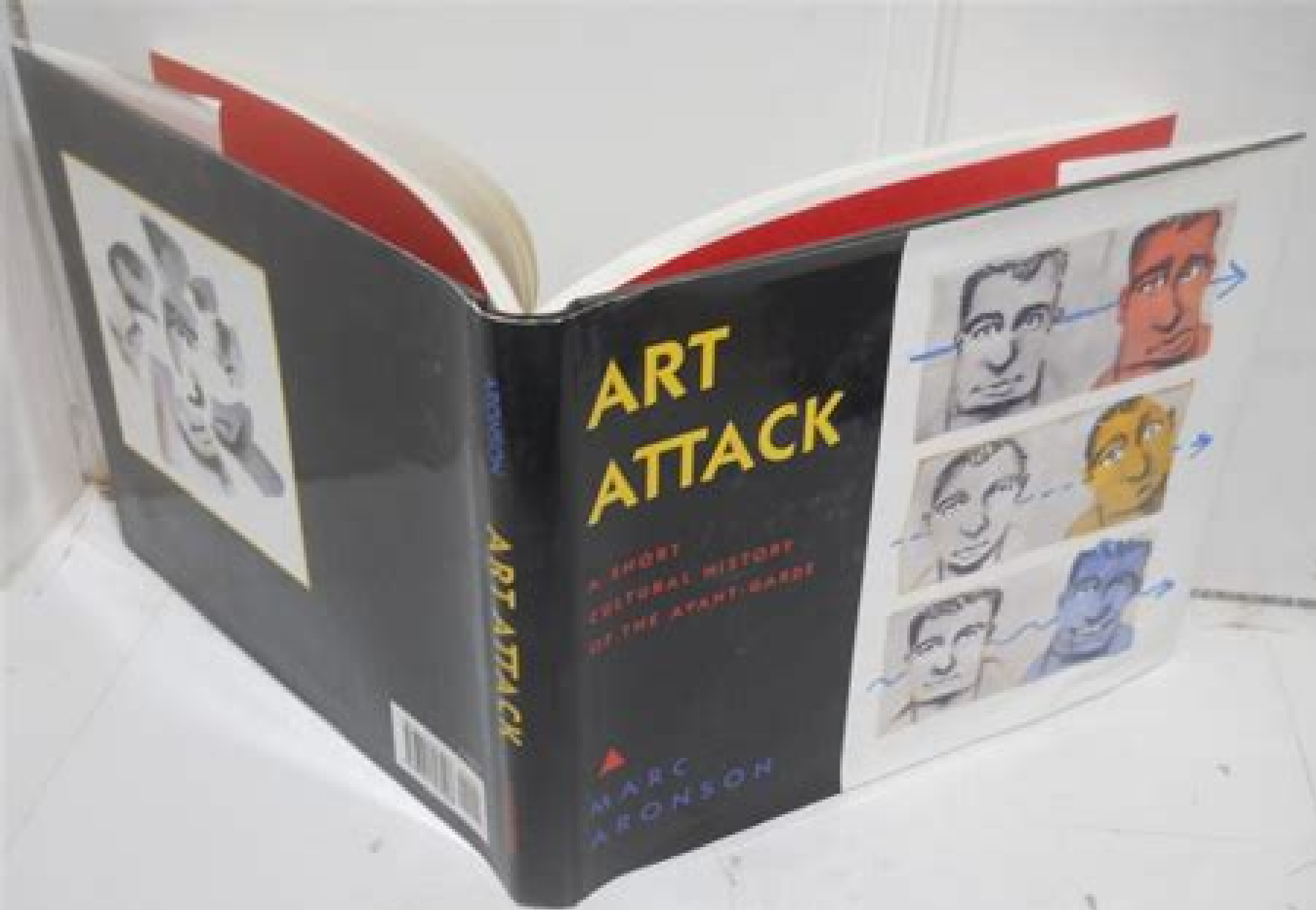

Maerhofer, 2009-05-27 How has political revolution figured into the development of avant garde cultural production Is the vanguard an antiquated concept or does its influence still resonate in the 21st century Focusing closely on the convergence of aesthetics and politics that materialized in the early part of the twentieth century this study offers a re interpretation of the historical avant garde from 1917 to 1962 a turbulent period in intellectual history which marked the apex crisis and decline of vanguardist authority Moving from the impact of the Bolshevik Revolution to the anti imperialist and decolonizing movements in the Third World to the emergence of neo vanguardism in the wake of postmodernity this study opens the way for understanding the transformation of vanguardist cultural paradigms from a global perspective the implications of which also reveal its relevance and application to the contemporary period Visual Vitriol David A. Ensminger, 2011-06-16 Visual Vitriol The Street Art and Subcultures of the Punk and Hardcore Generation is a vibrant in depth and visually appealing history of punk which reveals punk concert flyers as urban folk art David Ensminger exposes the movement s deeply participatory street art including flyers stencils and graffiti This discovery leads him to an examination of the often overlooked presence of African Americans Latinos women and gays and lesbians who have widely impacted the worldviews and music of this subculture Then Ensminger the former editor of fanzine *Left of the Dial* looks at how mainstream and punk media shape the public s outlook on the music s history and significance Often derided as litter or a nuisance punk posters have been called instant art Xerox art or DIY street art For marginalized communities they carve out spaces for resistance Made by hand in a vernacular tradition this art highlights deep seated tendencies among musicians and fans Instead of presenting punk as a predominately middle class white male phenomenon the book describes a convergence culture that mixes people gender and sexualities This detailed account reveals how members conceptualize their attitudes express their aesthetics and talk to each other about complicated issues Ensminger incorporates an important array of scholarship ranging from sociology and feminism to musicology and folklore in an accessible style Grounded in fieldwork Visual Vitriol includes over a dozen interviews completed over the last several years with some of the most recognized and important members of groups such as Minor Threat The Minutemen The Dils Chelsea Membranes 999 Youth Brigade Black Flag Pere Ubu the Descendents the Buzzcocks and others History of the Literary Cultures of East-Central Europe Marcel Cornis-Pope, John Neubauer, 2006-09-13 Continuing the work undertaken in Vol 1 of the *History of the Literary Cultures of East Central Europe* Vol 2 considers various topographic sites multicultural cities border areas cross cultural corridors multiethnic regions that cut across national boundaries rendering them permeable to the flow of hybrid cultural messages By focusing on the literary cultures of specific geographical locations this volume intends to put into practice a new type of comparative study Traditional comparative literary studies establish transnational comparisons and contrasts but thereby reconfirm however inadvertently the very national borders they play down This volume inverts the expansive momentum of comparative studies towards ever broader regional European and world literary histories While the theater of this volume is

still the literary culture of East Central Europe the contributors focus on pinpointed local traditions and geographic nodal points Their histories of Riga Plovdiv Timi oara or Budapest of Transylvania or the Danube corridor to take a few examples reveal how each of these sites was during the last two hundred years a home for a variety of foreign or ethnic literary traditions next to the one now dominant within the national borders By foregrounding such non national or hybrid traditions this volume pleads for a diversification and pluralization of local and national histories A genuine comparatist revival of literary history should involve the recognition that treading on native grounds means actually treading on grounds cultivated by diverse people
