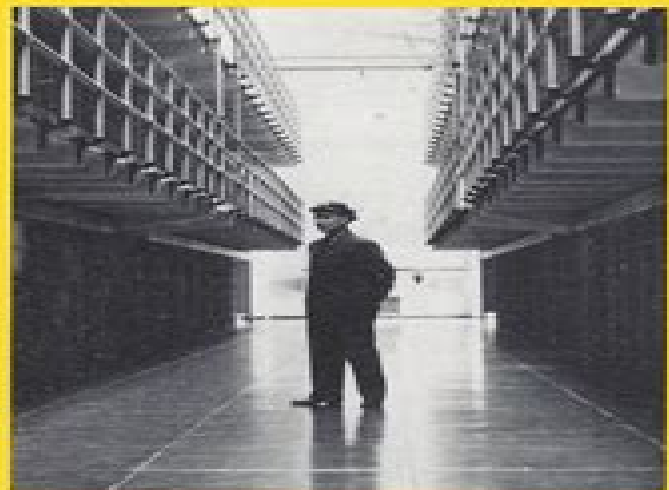
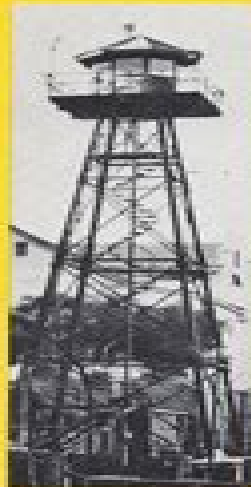

In this open access book, Larissa Hugentobler explores the world of public memorials, highly visible and at times contentious media which communicate a nation's values and ideals, its public memory. By celebrating a selection of a nation's history, the memorial landscape has long rendered marginalized groups virtually invisible. This book focuses on two rare celebratory U.S. memorials in Washington, DC, dedicated to a member of a marginalized community: Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. The author explores how visitors experience the two cultural sites, including their narratives about King and the Civil Rights Movement. For a holistic understanding, Hugentobler combines analyses of visitor experiences on site and on Instagram with expert interviews and autoethnographies. This allows for insights into the importance of celebratory memorials to individuals from marginalized communities and why those memorials matter to visitors. By acknowledging that the memorial experience is not limited to the time and space of a visit, this book begins to answer the urgent question of the roles of the offline and online realms in commemoration and highlights how each can contribute to a memorial landscape that is meaningful to a variety of people.

This edited collection expands scholarly and popular conversations about dark tourism in the American West. The phenomenon of dark tourism, traveling to sites of death, suffering, and disaster for entertainment or educational purposes, has been described and, on occasion, criticized for transforming misfortune and catastrophe into commodity. The impulse, however, continues, particularly in the American West, a liminal and contested space that resonates with stories of tragedy, violent conflict, and disaster. Contributions here specifically examine the mediation and shaping of these spaces into touristic destinations. The essays examine Western sites of massacre and battle, such as Sand Creek Massacre National Historic Site and the Waco Siege, sites of imprisonment such as Japanese American internment camps and Alcatraz Island, areas devastated by ecological disaster such as Martin's Cove and the Salton

Sea and unmediated sites those sites left to the touristic imagination with no interpretation of what occurred there such as the Bennet Arcane camp

Alcatraz Screw George H. Gregory, 2013-12-17 Alcatraz Screw is a firsthand account from a prison guard s perspective of some of the most storied years at the infamous U S Penitentiary at Alcatraz George Gregory began his career as a guard for the Federal Bureau of Prisons in 1940 Following his training he was sent to the federal prison at Sandstone Minnesota A few years later he enlisted in the Marine Corps Badly wounded at Iwo Jima he returned to Sandstone after a long rehabilitation When the Bureau of Prisons closed Sandstone in 1947 Gregory was transferred to Alcatraz which had been a federal penitentiary since 1934 For the next fifteen years Gregory worked on The Rock He takes the reader along on a correctional officer s tour of duty showing what it was like to pull a lonely tedious night of sentry duty in the Road Tower or witness illicit transactions in the clothing room or forcibly quell a riot in the cell blocks Gregory provides an insider s account of the tenures of all four of Alcatraz s wardens and their sometimes contradictory approaches to administering the institution He knew and regularly interacted with such legendary inmates as Robert Stroud the Birdman of Alcatraz and George Machine Gun Kelly Without glamorizing or demonizing either the staff or the convicts Alcatraz Screw provides a candid portrayal of corruption drug abuse and sexual practices as well as efforts at reform and unrecorded acts of kindness Various incidents in the memoir convey the fear hatred frustration boredom and unavoidable tension of being incarcerated With the inclusion of maps and diagrams of Alcatraz Island as well as photographs of inmates officers and the prison itself this book offers insight into life at the notorious Alcatraz from an unprecedented perspective

Composing Place takes an innovative approach to engaging with the compositional affordances of mobile technologies. Mobile wearable and spatial computing technologies are more than the latest marketing gimmick from a perpetually proximate future; they are rather an emerging composing platform through which digital writers will increasingly create and distribute place-based multimodal texts. Jacob Greene utilizes and develops a rhetorical framework through which writers can leverage the affordances of these technologies by drawing on theoretical approaches within rhetorical studies, multimodal composition, and spatial theory, as well as emerging maker practices within digital humanities and critical media studies, to show how emerging mobile technologies are poised to transform theories, practices, and pedagogies of digital writing. Greene identifies three emerging modalities through which mobile technologies are being used by digital writers: first, to counter dominant discourses in contested spaces; second, to historicize entrenched narratives in iconic spaces; and third, to amplify marginalized voices in mundane spaces. Through these modalities, Greene employs Indigenous philosophies and theories that upend the ways that the discipline has centered place-based rhetorics, offering digital writers better strategies for using mobile media as a platform for civic deliberation, social advocacy, and political action. *Composing Place* offers close analyses of mobile media experiences created by various artists and digital media practitioners, as well as detailed overviews of Greene's own projects, also accessible through the companion website www.composingplace.com. These projects include a digital countertour of SeaWorld that demonstrates the ways in which the attraction is driven by capitalism, an augmented reality tour of Detroit's Woodward Avenue, and a mobile advocacy project in Jacksonville, Florida, that demonstrates the inequitable effects of car-centric public infrastructure. Ultimately, by engaging with these theoretical frameworks, rhetorical design principles, and pedagogical practices of mobile writing, readers can utilize the unique affordances of mobile media in various teaching and research contexts.
