Elliott, 2023-10-25 Originally published in 1977 Albany Birth of a Prison End of an Era attempts to document and analyse some of the changes which happened in the first five and a half years of the prison's opening and as far as possible account for them Albany was planned and built as a medium security establishment but the growth in the prison population meant it ended up in part as a maximum security unit At the time the prison was notorious after a stormy series of incidents culminated in an alleged mass escape attempt and a riot it had become known as the jail of fear in which mafia groups were said to terrorize staff and prisoners alike Despite the account inevitably being incomplete it was hoped that lessons could be drawn both for social research and social policy in regard to prisons
