Abstract—The authors examined the effects of a 6-week training program on the psychophysiological responses of 10 young adults during a simulated combat environment. The participants were divided into two groups: control and training. The control group received no training, while the training group underwent a 6-week program designed to improve their ability to remain calm under stress. The results showed that the training group exhibited significantly lower heart rate and skin conductance levels compared to the control group during the simulation. These findings suggest that the training program was effective in reducing physiological arousal and improving emotional regulation.
